

**City of Hillsboro City Council
Notice of Public Hearing
On Creation of Reinvestment Zone**

The City Council of the City of Hillsboro, Texas will hold a public hearing at the regular meeting of the City Council on Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. at Historic City Hall at 127 East Franklin. The purpose of the hearing is to hear comments from the public regarding the creation of a Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone to fund infrastructure improvements in the Hillsboro Industrial Park and its benefits to the City of Hillsboro and the properties in the proposed reinvestment zone, which proposed zone consists of approximately ±980 acres generally located in the City of Hillsboro, Texas in Hill County, and generally located SOUTH OF HILL COUNTY ROAD 4231, NORTH OF OLD BRANDON ROAD AND EAST FRANKLIN, EAST OF INTERSTATE 35 AND WEST OF ITASCA ROAD, as more particularly depicted by a map available at the City of Hillsboro Administration Building at 214 East Elm Street and available for public inspection. Interested persons are invited to speak for or against the creation of the zone, its proposed boundaries, and/or the concept of tax increment financing.
