**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A
MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ENTRYPOINT NETWORKS, INC.
TO PROVIDE PROJECT MANAGEMENT, CONSTRUCTION, AND
OPERATIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE DEPLOYMENT OF FIBER-
OPTIC COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE AND ADVANCED
NETWORKING SOLUTIONS FOR THE BROADBAND FIBER PLANNING
PROJECT (CIP #42340)**

WHEREAS, the City Council approved an agreement with EntryPoint Networks, Inc. on May 25, 2021 for consulting services to develop the City's Broadband Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan was completed by EntryPoint in October of 2021; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2022, the City was awarded a Local Agency Technical Assistance Grant from the State of California to assist in implementation of the City's Broadband Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a new agreement with EntryPoint Networks, Inc. on March 14, 2023 to continue implementation of the Broadband Master Plan, and

WHEREAS, the California Public Utility Commission awarded a \$20,198,943 Last Mile Federal Funding Account Grant (Resolution T-17845); and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to enter into a new master services agreement with EntryPoint Networks, Inc. to continue implementation of the Broadband Master Plan including the work approved in the Local Agency Technical Assistance Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

Authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Master Services Agreement with EntryPoint Networks, Inc. to provide project management, construction, and operational services related to the deployment of fiber-optic communications infrastructure and advanced networking solutions for the City's Broadband Fiber Planning project (CIP #42340).
