**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
ADOPTING A FINAL INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE  
DECLARATION PREPARED FOR THE SEWER LINE RELOCATION – CLAY  
STREET TO LOCUST AVENUE PROJECT (CIP #41202) AND APPROVING THE  
PROJECT, AND APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE CONSULTING  
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DEWBERRY ENGINEERS INC. IN AN  
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$188,240 FOR THE SAID PROJECT, AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME; AND  
APPROVING A BUDGT APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 FROM  
THE MEASURE L FUND FOR THE SAID PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City established the Sewer Relocation – Clay Street to Locust Avenue project (CIP #41202) to relocate the 16-inch trunk sewer from its current alignment within Hangtown Creek; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2019 , the City Council awarded a Consulting Services Agreement to Drake Haglan and Associates for design services for the project in the amount of \$186,335; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2022, the City Council approved Amendment No. 2 to the Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry | Drake Haglan for additional environmental studies; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 13, 2022, the City Council approved Amendment No. 3 to the Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry | Drake Haglan for additional environmental studies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and its consultant prepared an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) of environmental impacts for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the draft IS/MND was circulated for public review on November 20, 2024 and closed on December 23, 2024, and the City received and responded to written comments within the revised Final IS/MND attached hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed and considered the proposed Final IS/MND, as well as all comments received during the review period; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds the basis of the whole record before it, including the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant impact on the environment with the implementation of the mitigation measures contained within the Final IS/MND and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Final Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for this Project reflects the Council's independent judgment and analysis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Final Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and all comments received and other materials constituting the record of proceedings are on file within the Engineering Department located at 3101 Center Street, Placerville, California; and

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting held on June 3, 2024, the Measures H/L Sales Tax Committee recommended that the City Council approve a \$250,000 budget appropriation from the Measures L Fund for the Sewer Relocation – Clay Street to Locust Avenue project (CIP #41202); and

**WHEREAS**, additional consulting engineering services are needed to complete the final design and right-of-way phases of the project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Adopt a Final Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the Sewer Line Relocation – Clay Street to Locust Avenue project (CIP #41202) pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and approve the project; and
2. Approve Amendment No. 4 to the Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers Inc. in the amount of \$188,240 for the said project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
3. Approve a budget appropriation in the amount of \$250,000 from the Measure L Fund for the said project.
