



CITY OF DOVER PROPOSED ORDINANCE #2024-21

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IN COUNCIL MET:

That Chapter 98 – Streets, Sidewalks, Storm Sewers, and Other Public Places, be amended by inserting new Articles as follows:

ARTICLE IX. – STREET SWEEPING

Sec. 98-347 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS, STORM SEWERS, AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES

(a) Street Sweeping

- (1) The City Manager or his / her designee shall provide street sweeping services within the city at the frequency and locations determined to be in the best interest of the city.**
- (2) Street sweeping shall meet or exceed the requirements set forth by the NPDES permit issued to the City of Dover.**
- (3) Any areas determined to require parking restrictions to provide adequate street sweeping services must be adequately marked by the city.**

ARTICLE X. – LEAF COLLECTION SERVICES

(a) Leaf Collection

- (1) The City Manager or his / her designee shall provide leaf collection services within the city at the frequency and locations determined to be in the best interest of the city.**
- (2) Leaf piles shall not be placed out for collection more than one day prior to collection day.**
- (3) Leaf piles shall be no larger than 3 feet wide by 3 feet tall. Leaf piles shall not be placed near catch basins or within the gutter pan. Clear space of 3 feet shall be provided on either end of leaf piles.**
- (4) Leaves shall not be bagged or tarped when put out for leaf collection services.**

- 40 **(5) Leaf piles shall not contain limbs, sod, concrete, trash, or other foreign material.**

- 42 **(6) Leaf piles put out for leaf collection services that are not in conformance with the**
- 43 **parameters above may not be collected.**
