



CITY OF DOVER PROPOSED ORDINANCE #2024-21

1 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IN**
2 **COUNCIL MET:**

4 That Chapter 98 – Streets, Sidewalks, Storm Sewers, and Other Public Places, be amended by
5 inserting new Articles as follows:

7 **ARTICLE IX. – STREET SWEEPING**

9 **Sec. 98-347 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS, STORM SEWERS, AND OTHER PUBLIC**
10 **PLACES**

12 **(a) Street Sweeping**

14 **(1) The City Manager or his / her designee shall provide street sweeping services**
15 **within the city at the frequency and locations determined to be in the best interest**
16 **of the city.**
17
18 **(2) Street sweeping shall meet or exceed the requirements set forth by the NPDES**
19 **permit issued to the City of Dover.**
20
21 **(3) Any areas determined to require parking restrictions to provide adequate street**
22 **sweeping services must be adequately marked by the city.**

24 **ARTICLE X. – LEAF COLLECTION SERVICES**

26 **(a) Leaf Collection**

- 27
28 **(1) The City Manager or his / her designee shall provide leaf collection services within**
29 **the city at the frequency and locations determined to be in the best interest of the**
30 **city.**
31
32 **(2) Leaf piles shall not be placed out for collection more than one day prior to**
33 **collection day.**
34 **(3) Leaf piles shall be no larger than 3 feet wide by 3 feet tall. Leaf piles shall not be**
35 **placed near catch basins or within the gutter pan. Clear space of 3 feet shall be**
36 **provided on either end of leaf piles.**

38 **(4) Leaves shall not be bagged or tarped when put out for leaf collection services.**

- (5) Leaf piles shall not contain limbs, sod, concrete, trash, or other foreign material.**
- (6) Leaf piles put out for leaf collection services that are not in conformance with the parameters above may not be collected.**
