*Registration for youth and adult activities will begin **Monday**, **December 4** in person and online (recpro.teanecknj.gov) or drop-box in the Rodda Center Lobby.

*Pre-registration is required for all activities. <u>Proof of residency is required for all residents</u>, <u>proof of age is required for all youth programs</u> (unless your child has previously registered for classes, proof of age is not required).

Youth programs will begin the week of January 2. Most classes will run for 8 weeks (with some exceptions).

WINTER 2024 YOUTH PROGRAMS (ages 18 months to 17 years)

After School Program - This program provides a nourishing and safe environment with organized recreational activities including homework time, homework assistance, and games. Snacks are included each afternoon as a part of each day's activities. The program operates from school dismissal to 6:00p.m. during the school year and observes all school and municipal holidays. Monday through Friday, Rodda Center, \$150.00 per month (sibling same-household \$125.00). Applications are available at the Rodda Center for the school year or on our website at: www.teanecknj.gov. <u>Arts & Crafts</u> - Students ages 5-8 will be introduced to the rich cultural diversity found in art. The method of instruction is student-centered, encouraging each child to develop their individual creativity through art. **Sundays**, 9:30-10:15 a.m. (5 & 6) or 10:30-11:15 a.m. (7 & 8) Rodda Center. \$60 (residents) \$120 (non-residents), 8 weeks. *Please wear old clothing to class.

<u>Ballet with Kerri</u> - Students ages 6-8 will acquire a basic vocabulary of ballet techniques, as well as the ability to coordinate simple movements to achieve a combination of steps within the range of their own physical capacity. Wednesdays or Thursdays, 5:00-5:55 p.m., Rodda Center. \$60 (residents) \$120 (non-residents). 8 weeks. *Please wear a leotard and leggings or form-fitting clothing to every class. Ballet shoes/slippers are required.

<u>Code with TechRoots</u> - Students ages 8-11 will learn the basics on how to create mobile applications, computer art, games and websites. TechRoots Academy will guide students through hands-on coding exercises and support students critical thinking while teaching them the fundamentals of computer programing techniques. Tuesdays, 4:00 - 5:00 p.m., Rodda Center, \$150 (residents) and \$200 (non-residents), 5 weeks. *We strongly encourage students to bring their own laptop/tablet; loaner equipment will be available if needed.

<u>Multi Sports Squirts</u> - This fun sports program is designed for children ages 3 to 5 years old. Participants will have the opportunity to learn and experience sports like Lacrosse, Soccer,

T-Ball, and Track & Field. Sundays, 9:00-9:50 a.m. or 10:00-10:50 a.m. Rodda Center. \$135 (residents) \$200 (non-residents). 6 weeks.

<u>Primary Picassos</u> - Students ages 7-11 will discover the process of painting composition and have fun while producing quality work. Students will learn about design elements, planning and technique, while having the opportunity to learn acrylic and watercolor painting techniques. **Sundays**,

11:30 a.m.-12:15 p.m. (7-9) or 12:30 p.m.-1:15 p.m. (7-11) Rodda Center, \$60 (residents) \$120 (non-residents), **8** weeks.

<u>Soccer Squirts</u> - This is the perfect introduction to the most popular sport in the world! Boys and girls ages 3-5 will learn the fundamental skills of soccer, including dribbling, passing, shooting and defending. **Tuesdays**, 3:30-4:20 p.m. (4-6) or 4:30-5:20 p.m. (5-7), Rodda Center, \$135. <u>Sunshine Garden Learning Center</u> - This program is a full-day early childhood learning experience for 3 & 4 year olds. The hours are 9:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. and the curriculum is Montessori-based. The staff of professional educators guide the child's socialization and developmental skills through interactive and multi-sensory experiences, where avenues of art, music, science, social studies and literature are explored. After-care until 6:00p.m. is available for an additional fee. The 2023-2024 school year registration is on-going until maximum capacity is reached.

<u>Toddlekins</u> - This is a "Toddler and Me" program for moms, dads, or caregivers along with their children ages 18 to 36 months. Children will discover the joy of movement with music, dance, hand games, and songs to focus on large motor skills as well as important socialization skills.
