Request: This is a request change the zoning of an existing lot from B-2 Hwy Bus to AR-1 Ag Res to reflect its current use as a residential lot.



2. Comments

- 1. This lot was zoned from R-1 SF Res to B-2 Hwy Bus in 1989 to be used for retail sales and a bed & breakfast establishment. At that time, all uses required a Conditional Use Permit and there was none granted for a single family residence. In the years since, this has become the use of the property which, technically, is not consistent with the current zoning.
- 2. If approved, the lot will be eligible for one single family residence and accessory structures.

3. Per Section 11.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered when deciding a zoning change:

- 1. The petition is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan and the comprehensive plan of any Town affected by said petition.
- Adequate public facilities and services (including sewage and waste disposal, water, gas, electricity, schools, police and fire protection, and roads and transportation, as applicable) will be available as required by the petition while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development.
- 3. Provisions of public facilities to accommodate the petition will not place an unreasonable burden on the ability of affected local units of government to provide the.
- 4. The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
- 5. The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
- 6. The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
- 7. The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
- 8. The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).

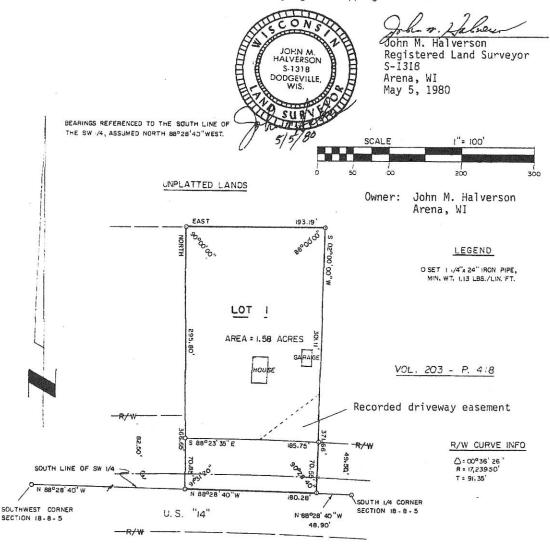

- II. Please explain the reason for the request and proposed plans: Immediate anticipated use will be as an Residential Recreational Rental property for one related group at a time. Our plan is to have three bedrooms in the current house and up to two sleeping areas in the summer kitchen. We'd like to reserve the right to rebuild the collapsed barn in a few years' time at the earliest as an additional rental unit or a permanent small residential unit for our family. We will be using the house as our second residence when not occupied by guests.

The intent of this Recreational Residential Rental will be to afford the cost of restoration/renovation and because I love to host guests. We will provide a comfortable, beautiful guest house for visitors to the River Valley area to relax, gather with family/friends, take advantage of the natural recreational features of the area, as well as the many local attractions such as the local brewery and cheese factory, cultural offerings such as APT and Taliesin, farm stands, and other retail and restaurants. Additionally, we wish to celebrate the builder of the 1868 house, and co-founder of Arena, William Henry Brisbane, and his legacy as an abolitionist. Because this house is on the National Register of Historic Places, we plan to work hard to restore the house within the Secretary of the Interiors' guidelines as well as bring it up to contemporary standards, including a new well and septic. We will be applying for state and federal income tax credit for the renovation.

 - -The house will be used as it is now, as a residence, but it will be a rental. It will be rented to one vetted related group at a time, year-round. Rentals are likeliest over the weekends, but we anticipate there will be some weekly and perhaps even monthly rentals. The minimum stay will be two days. The average number of guests will likely be four to six (but will range from two to 10). Furthermore, since this house is on the National Register of Historic Places, it will likely attract guests who are interested in heritage tourism and who understand that it will need to be treated respectfully.
 - -Since the footprint of the property will not be enlarged, all activity will be confined to the house, the yard, or in the woods on our property or on Sue Steinmann's property to the south (walking on trails).
 - -Guests can arrive in one or more cars, which can be parked in the driveway directly

adjacent to the house or inside the four-car garage on the property. There is ample parking on the house's circular drive, as well. No parking will be allowed along the shared road to any neighboring properties unless the neighbors are informed and consent in advance.

-We are cognizant of light pollution and therefore no bright lights other than what would be acceptable for a residence will be added. We will restore the old lamppost (missing its lantern) to the north east of the house, as well as possibly illuminate a wreath on the side of the house during the holidays.

-Dogs would be allowed off leash on our property only.

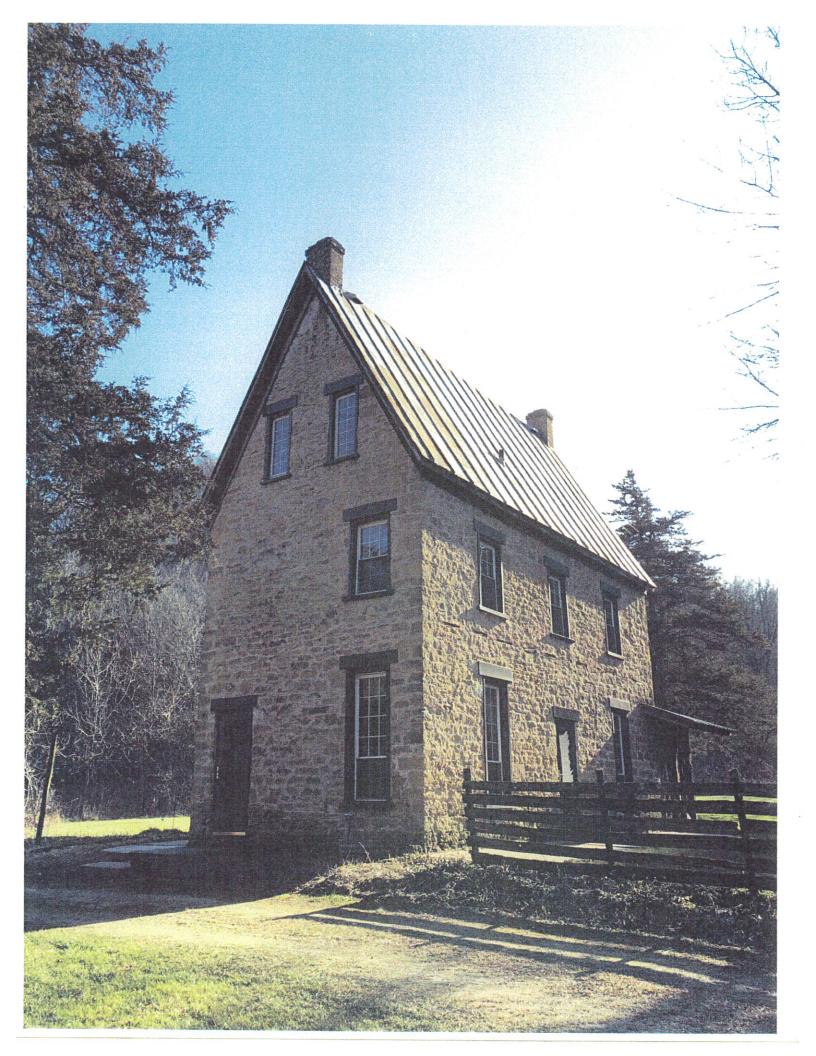
- -We will be required to be inspected by the State Health Department annually.
- -We will not tolerate loud noise or behavior that will disturb our neighbors at the house.
 -On a side note, my husband, Bruce is a visual artist and his mentor was the late Bill Weege (Sue Steinmann's husband and our neighbor to the south). Bruce will be using Bill's studio on a periodic basis, so we will be in the neighborhood. Although we live in Madison, we will take a very active part in running this business, as well as living there periodically. We will take care of the surrounding woods and the pine forest through the DNR managed forest program.
- 3. Do you feel there will be significant anticipated measurable adverse impacts to the surrounding legal uses and environment resulting from the proposed conditional use and why? No, each guest will be vetted (they will have had previous reviews by other hosts via Airbnb). We will provide a house manual, and will require they be respectful of our property and neighborhood. We anticipate being good stewards of the property and will work to correct any issues or complaints from neighbors. We are very involved in our Madison community where we have run an Airbnb out of our home for the past eight years. We worked with our alderwoman, who lives next door, to create the Madison Ordinance regulating Airbnbs. We have been designated Superhosts ever since the program started which means that we are rated five stars out of five in eight categories by guests, including overall experience, cleanliness, accuracy, check-in, communication, location, value, and amenities. Our neighbors are very supportive of our business and no complaints have ever been filed.
- 4. How can any adverse impacts resulting from the use be mitigated or offset to the maximum practical extent? We will work to identify potential issues before they arise by thinking through our plans, have open lines of communication with our neighbors, and work to correct any issues that arise. We will carry sufficient insurance. I will personally manage all rentals and for the foreseeable future will be on site before and after each guest. Again, we have done this relatively flawlessly with our primary residence for the past eight years.
- 5. Do public safety, transportation, services, and utility facilities exist or will they be available to serve the subject property while maintaining sufficient levels of service for existing development? None will be needed.
- 6. What assurances can be provided for potential continuing maintenance associated with the use? We will maintain the property and will devote the generated income to pay our mortgage and construction/restoration loan and future maintenance. We will develop a 10-20 year preservation plan with larger scheduled maintenance. We will be investing about as much

into the restoration of the property as it will cost us to purchase it. We will work hard to meticulously protect and enhance our investment.

7. How do you feel the proposed use is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan? The Plan's goal is to "Maintain rural character with a diverse landscape. Improve agricultural opportunities as well as control commercial growth." We are interested in promoting many of the key objectives and share many of values identified in the Plan such as:

• Iowa County Strengths: #1 Rural/Natural Beauty-Rural Character/Atmosphere.

- Iowa County Opportunities: #1(tie) Business and Industry Creation, attraction, and support. Toward bottom of list, tourism.
- Issues Summary: #1 Preservation of Natural Resources.
- Weaknesses: Lack of job opportunities—we anticipate employing lots of local trades people and sporadic cleaning help—and to add tourism dollars to the local economies.
- We will be protecting and promoting a natural and cultural (historic preservation) resource to provide recreational opportunities as well as preserving and enhancing an irreplaceable historic structure. The "Brisbane House" is the number one historic landmark for Arena. We will work to promote tourism and are happy to collaborate with organizations and programs to tell the story of the Brisbane House and his legacy.
- We will also responsibly manage our woods and wildlife with guidance from the Prairie Enthusiasts, the DNR, and other groups.
