Economic Development Structure Grant

As part of Iowa County's strategic planning, a greater County-wide effort is being made in the arena of Economic Development. Iowa County recognizes that our government's ability to provide public services in the future will depend heavily on growing our tax base. Iowa County is asking to serve as a partner in community economic development efforts and this grant will help facilitate that in two separate ways:

- 1. The County Board has decided that in order to partner with Cities and Villages, they have made certain funds available to help fund economic development initiatives in lowa County. The funds are to be used to cover up to 90% of the cost of hiring a grant writer; who shall be pursing funds that will further economic development in an lowa County City or Village.
- 2. Applicants must send a representative to the "lowa County Economic Development" monthly meetings. This group will discuss ways of encouraging further economic growth across the County.

To Apply:

- a. Fill out the attached short application form.
- b. Applicants must present their "use of funds" to the Iowa County Revolving Loan Fund Committee and answer questions about the proposed project prior to their approval.
- c. The applicant, should they be successful in the project they received a Structure Grant for, must attend a County Board meeting and explain how the Structure Grant they received helped their Economic Development efforts.

It is our hope to make this a simple process, distribute all of the Structure Grant dollars available and to see new economic development capacity and tax base as a result. Please let us know if we can make this process any easier for you.



Economic Development Program Re:

Dear City/Village Clerk,

lowa County would like to begin organizing a group of community representatives from around the County who are interested in Economic Development.

lowa County Government has moved in a new direction with our Economic Development efforts. The County formerly provided staff time via a contract with Regional Planning. Starting in 2017, we plan to use those funds slightly differently. The County's Revolving Loan Fund Committee will be implementing a new program that would grant over \$50,000 to Cities and Villages within Iowa County.

The terms of the grant program have not been completely defined at this time; however it will likely include the following:

- 1. The funds are to be used to cover up to 90% of the cost of hiring a grant writer; who shall be pursing funds that will further economic development in an lowa County community.
- 2. Applicants must send a representative to the "lowa County Economic Development" monthly meetings. This group will discuss ways of encouraging further economic growth across the County and future funding awards will consider meeting attendance.

The purpose of this letter is to begin establishing Economic Development monthly meetings. Our first meeting will be held on April 24th at 7 PM in the Community Room of the Health and Human Services Building in Dodgeville. I anticipate that the grant program adopted by Iowa County will be introduced at this meeting. We will also discuss various economic development projects, and your representative will be asked to provide an update on economic activity in your community. Please consider sending a representative or two to this and future Economic Development meetings.
