## 2. Comments

1. Currently, the Schofield land is nonconforming A-1 Ag due to being less than the minimum 40-acre lot size for that district and having been created since that lot size took effect. The Jensen land is legal nonconforming A-1 as it was created before the minimum 40-acre size took effect. This proposal to

- alter both properties into 3 lots requires rezoning as none of the proposed lots meet the current minimum 40-acre lot size to remain A-1.
- 2. If approved, each lot would be eligible for one single family residence, accessory buildings and limited ag uses, including up to 3 animal units as defined in the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, on the two larger lots but none on the smaller lot without a Conditional Use Permit.
- 3. The associated certified survey map has not yet been submitted for formal review.
- **4.** Per Section 11.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered when deciding a zoning change:
  - 1) The petition is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan and the comprehensive plan of any Town affected by said petition.
  - 2) Adequate public facilities and services (including sewage and waste disposal, water, gas, electricity, schools, police and fire protection, and roads and transportation, as applicable) will be available as required by the petition while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development.
  - 3) Provisions of public facilities to accommodate the petition will not place an unreasonable burden on the ability of affected local units of government to provide those services.
  - 4) The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
  - 5) The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
  - 6) The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
  - 7) The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
  - 8) The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).

Town Recommendation: The Town of Arena is recommending approval. Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approval with the condition that the associated certified survey map is duly recorded within 6 months of County Board approval.

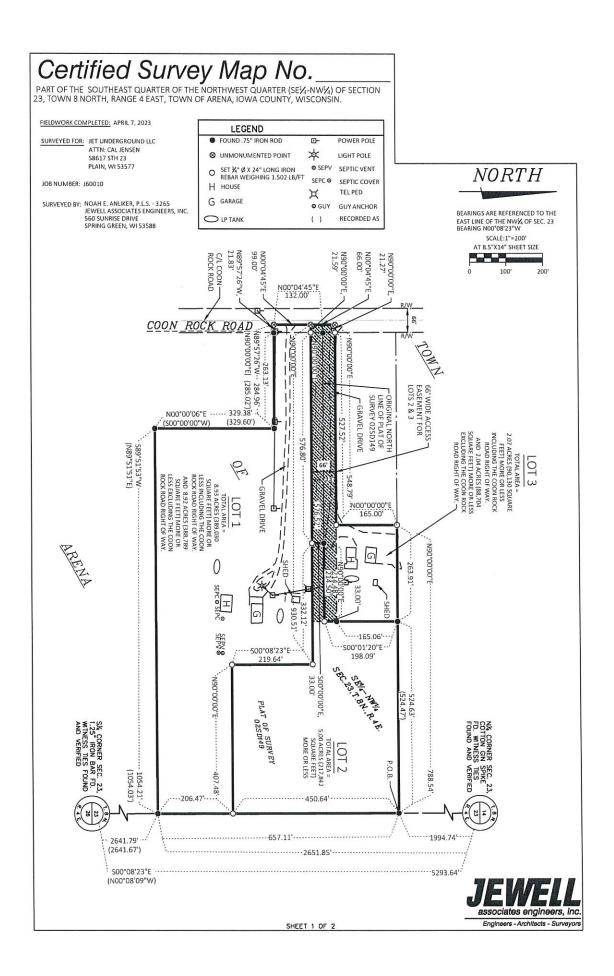

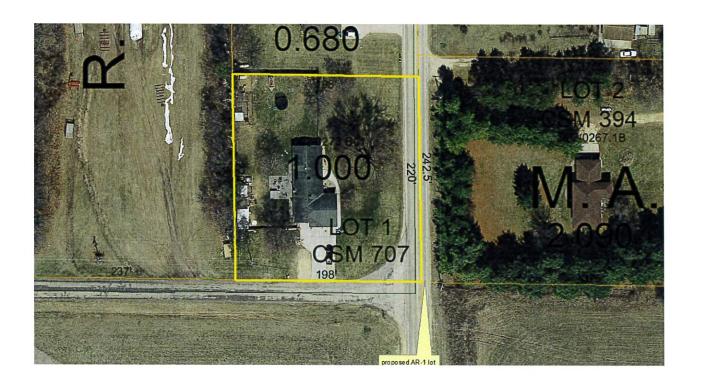
## 2. Comments

- 1. This lot was zoned R-1 SF Res when zoning was originally adopted as part of an area of existing residential development. The R-1 district doesn't provide for animal units, as defined in the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, which includes chickens. The applicants want to have up to 25 chickens (1 animal unit) as a Conditional Use Permit associated with this petition. The AR-1 district allows animal units.
- If approved, the AR-1 lot would allow one single family residence (existing), accessory structures and limited ag uses, but no animal units as defined in the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, without a Conditional Use Permit.

- 3. There is no land division proposed, so a certified survey map is not required.
- **4.** Per Section 11.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered when deciding a zoning change:
  - 1) The petition is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan and the comprehensive plan of any Town affected by said petition.
  - 2) Adequate public facilities and services (including sewage and waste disposal, water, gas, electricity, schools, police and fire protection, and roads and transportation, as applicable) will be available as required by the petition while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development.
  - 3) Provisions of public facilities to accommodate the petition will not place an unreasonable burden on the ability of affected local units of government to provide those services.
  - 4) The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
  - 5) The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
  - 6) The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
  - 7) The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
  - 8) The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).
- **5**. Per Section 4.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered for a CUP:
  - 1) The proposed use complies with all applicable provisions of this Ordinance.
  - 2) The proposed use is compatible with adjacent legal uses in terms of scale, site design, operating characteristics (hours of operation, traffic generation, lighting, noise, odor, dust and other external impacts).
  - 3) There are no significant anticipated measurable adverse impacts to the surrounding legal uses and environment resulting from the proposed conditional use.
  - 4) Any adverse impacts resulting from the use will be mitigated or offset to the maximum practical extent.
  - 5) Public safety, transportation, services and utility facilities exist or will be available to serve the subject property while maintaining sufficient levels of service for existing development.
  - 6) Adequate assurances by the applicant of continuing maintenance are provided.
  - 7) The proposed use is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan.

**Town Recommendation**: The Town of Arena is recommending approval of both the zoning change and Conditional Use Permit.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the zoning change. Staff recommends approval of the Conditional Use Permit with the condition that the animal unit consists only hen chickens due to being in an area of smaller, residential lots.

#### 2. Comments

- 1. The A-1 district has a minimum 40-acre lot size, so the proposed lot would require rezoning to be legally created.
- 2. The intent is to sell this lot for open-space use only, which the C-1 district allows but prohibits structures or buildings.

- 4) The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
- 5) The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
- 6) The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
- 7) The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
- 8) The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).

## 2. Comments

- 1. The minimum lot size for the A-1 district is 40 acres, so rezoning is required in order to legally create the proposed lot.
- 2. If approved, the AR-1 lot would be eligible for one single family residence (existing), accessory structures and limited ag uses and one animal unit as defined in the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance.

- 3. The associated certified survey map has been submitted for formal review.
- 4. Per Section 11.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered when deciding a zoning change:
  - The petition is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan and the comprehensive plan of any Town affected by said petition.
  - 2) Adequate public facilities and services (including sewage and waste disposal, water, gas, electricity, schools, police and fire protection, and roads and transportation, as applicable) will be available as required by the petition while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development.
  - 3) Provisions of public facilities to accommodate the petition will not place an unreasonable burden on the ability of affected local units of government to provide those services.
  - 4) The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
  - 5) The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
  - 6) The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
  - 7) The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
  - 8) The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).

**Town Recommendation**: The Town of Moscow is recommending approval. **Staff Recommendation**: Staff recommends approval with the condition that the associated certified survey map is recorded within 6 months of the County Board approval of the zoning change.

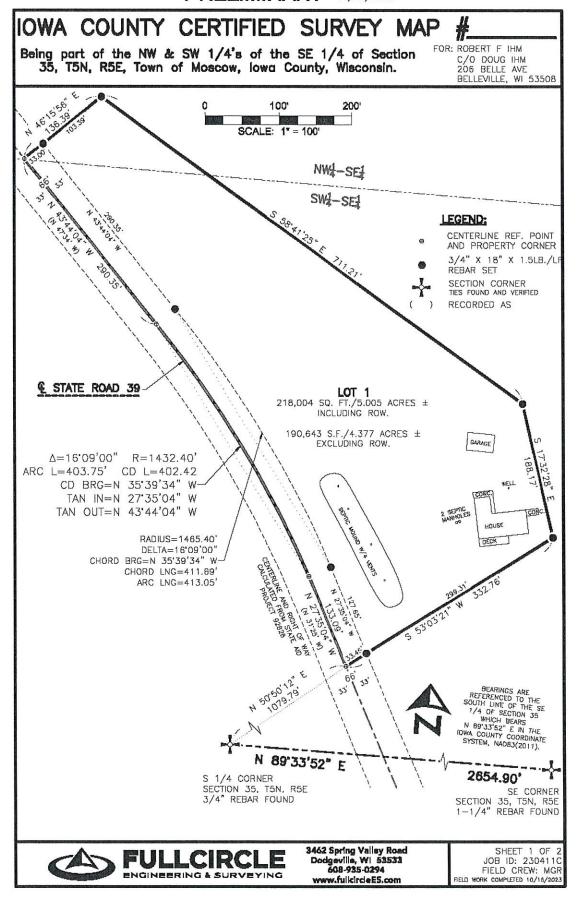
