SUN Program Executive Summary for Iowa Executive Committee

Drafted February 8, 2024

- December 2023 Financial Statement is provided (final numbers may move somewhat).
 Primarily thanks to a record-breaking Annual Campaign total just over \$30,000, SUN finished in much better shape for 2023 than in 2022 with a profit estimated around \$40,000.
- January 2024 Meal Counts are provided. We continue to see more demand and meals in home delivered category. SUN will need to attract more congregate diners and scale back home delivered meals to spend within its budget. Voucher applications are being submitted for partner restaurants to allow SUN to add dining locations without hiring more staff. This is logistically a better match for Lafayette and lowa Counties, which include many small towns, and adds less payroll.
- For a breakdown of the Annual Campaign, and for some other newly calculated statistics related to SUN, check out The SUN Shine Newsletter. The version you received may not be the final version that is posted online and mailed out.
- Reassessments or first-time assessments are being caught up for all program
 participants. These were not completed regularly since COVID (2020). Assessments are
 required for all participants receiving home delivered meals to ensure only the home
 bound are receiving meals. This needs to be emphasized for staff as a priority and
 requirement going forward.
- Both SUN vans are in poor shape. One has 188,000 miles, the other has 87,000 miles. Both are proving expensive to repair and not all volunteers are willing to trust these vehicles. The plan is to begin submitting grants for vehicle money with the hope to trade in or scrap both vans within 90 days.
- The Director and SUN Intern are submitting \$99,000 worth of grant proposals by May 8, with \$70,000 from 3 main grants at the end of that period. Most of these new foundations are being approached for small amounts under \$2,000. The large grants will be written with a capacity building approach, meaning some of the money requested will help with adding fundraising events in the second half of the year to strive for increased self-sufficiency in future years.
- A tax bill for unpaid payroll taxes totalling \$7,234.71, primarily from September of 2020, but also including March of 2022 arrived by mail on February 8, 2024. This includes late fees and penalties after a suspension of collections during COVID. A bill from an local appliance repair shop over \$1,000 from December of 2022 that had gone unpaid also needed a resolution in December of 2023.
- A line of credit maxed out at \$25,000 with interest at 5% still remains on SUN's books through Farmer's Bank. This will be resolved soon after reviewing options with the
