### • Birch Lake Dam:

O The contract for the Birch Lake dam valve replacement was signed in early April. Since then, the contractor has had difficulty hearing back from valve manufacturers. It is likely still at least twelve weeks before we can get the needed part.

## • Partnerships:

Oue to loss of federal grant funding and staff changes, Michael Fields Agriculture Institute is no longer able to coordinate and hold grants for the Iowa County Uplands Farmer-led Watership Group. I am working with them and DATCP to transfer those grants to Iowa County LCD.

### Outreach:

- We partnered with the Health Department for Groundwater Awareness Week in March, including a PFAS talk. The recording of that presentation is on the Health Department's website under the water testing topic. A nitrogen efficiency workshop for farmers was cancelled due to low registration, but we will try again for a different time of year.
- We have two field days coming up near Spring Green, in partnership with the Lowery Creek Watershed Initiative: Thursday July 24 about building good soil, and Thursday August 21 about monitoring invasive species (with Upper Sugar River Watershed Association).
- We will present our annual conservation awards at the Farmers Appreciation Day on July 13.


### Other:


- o The field season is underway, including about 130 farm visits for the Farmland Preservation Program and site visits for construction/design of structural projects, including two grassed waterways that were recently completed.
- We have begun writing our new 10-year Land and Water Resources Plan. We held the required Citizen Advisory Committee meeting in March and received helpful feedback. A draft is due to DATCP by August 1, and we need to hold a public hearing in October.
- Our internship posting was delayed due to grant issues and the cyberattack, but we did get some applications recently. If needed we can extend some of the funding and try again for 2026.


PARTITION TYPES

ROOF ASSEMBLIES









