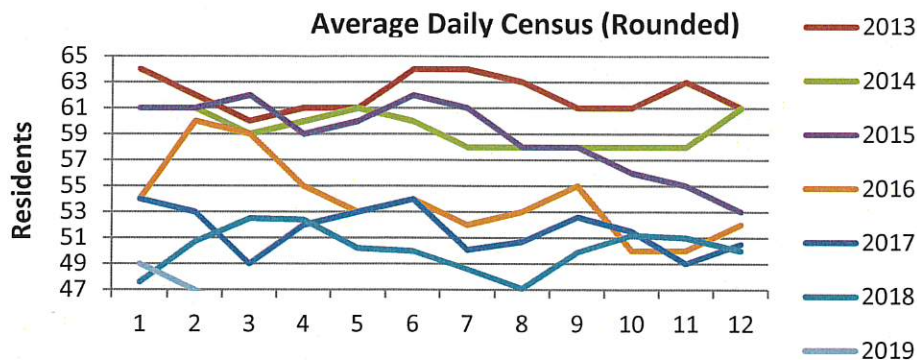

1	Meeting was called to order by Chair Paull at 1:32 p.m.
2	Roll Call. Present: Deal; Griffiths; Ladewig and Paull. Bierke entered meeting at 1:46 p.m. Others present: Rochelle Kruchten; Mary Crook; Jamie Duve; Hillary Taets; and Dan Nankee.
3	Approve the agenda for this December 16, 2019 meeting. Motion by Griffiths to approve the agenda of the December 16, 2019 meeting. Motion second by Ladewig. Aye: 3; Nay: 0. Motion carried.
4	Approve the minutes of the October 7, 2019 meeting. Motion by Deal to approve the minutes of the October 7, 2019 meeting. Motion second by Griffiths. Aye: 2; Nay: 0. Motion carried. Ladewig states he was not present at meeting and did not vote to approve.
5	Report from committee members and an opportunity for members of the audience to address the Committee. No action will be taken. Committee discusses that they are looking for a citizen member to add to the Bloomfield Commission. Griffiths thanks Bloomfield and members for card and thoughts regarding personal matter. Paull spoke of UHH and the space for therapy services, leading into a conversation regarding internet access in the Bloomfield facility. Kruchten states that she has spoken to IT regarding this and that there is not enough service at facility and that it can be difficult for just staff to use. Ladewig asked if Campbell Funds would be appropriate to fund internet/Wi-Fi because it would be to the benefit of residents and their families. Taets states that families ask about Wi-Fi often when residents are first admitted and that insurance companies come in to see patients and are unable to do work that they need because there is no public internet access. Paull brings up that 2 systems would be needed; 1 for staff to use and 1 for guests to use. Bierke states that it would be easier to get answers regarding internet access if it was a sure bet that Bloomfield would be staying in current building. Griffiths asks question regarding who is eligible to be a citizen member of the Bloomfield Commission and it is discussed that it cannot be a Bloomfield staff member but that it could be a resident or family that is currently residing in the building. Former board members may also be an option for this.
6	Dietary Update – Mary Crook. Crook discusses open positions in dietary department. Ladewig asks if Southwest Technical College students are a possibility for these openings. Kruchten explains how students living in facility is not an option due to the facility being licensed and this would count against the bed count. Crook describes some complaints regarding the SUN program meals that she has heard. These complaints are regarding food being cold when received and if there are any remedies to this issue. Paull states that this may be more of a transport issue because food is leaving Bloomfield at the required temperatures. Crook talks more in depth about SUN meal budget. Paull explains difficulties retaining trays and the pros and cons regarding the plastic vs. metal trays that are used.
7	Nursing Update – Jamie Duve. Duve states that a new nurse manager has been hired. There have been numerous admissions within the past month and current census is 48 with 3 potential admissions.

8	Administrators Report- Rochelle Kruchten. Ladewig brings up snow removal and how this is done for the Bloomfield campus. Kruchten says that the company was not the best last winter and that snow is not cleared in a timely manner and it normally takes a phone call to request these services are done. She also discusses the census and that the majority of residents are from Iowa County. Referrals are coming in from Upland Hills Health, Madison Hospitals (St. Mary's, Meriter, etc). Nankee asks about the employee relations position being cut and how and if this will affect the training or onboarding of staff. Kruchten states that there are not a lot of current openings and that her and Jessica Munson will be assisting with any new hires, along with Allison Leitzinger.
9	Chairman's Report- Chairman Paull. Nothing to report, all has been touched on in the meeting already. Paul does bring up the blood drive that will be happening at Bloomfield on January 16 th .
10	Business at Next Bloomfield Commission Meeting. Paull would like to talk more about the possibility of internet at Bloomfield and using the Campbell Funds to address this issue. Kruchten explains that we have not have our state survey yet and if this happens before the next meeting, it will be discussed.
11	Next Meeting Date. The next meeting will be Monday, January, 13, 2020 at 1:30 p.m.
12	Adjournment. Motion by Ladewig to adjourn. Motion second by Deal. Aye: 3; Nay: 0. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 2:38 p.m.
