Request: This is a request to rezone an existing 3.47-acre lot that is currently partially A-1 and R-1 to all R-1.



2. Comments

- 1. This is a lot within a platted subdivision created decades ago. The existing zoning dates back to 1993. The intent is to simply zone the entire platted lot all R-1 so it can be developed.
- 2. If approved, the lot will be eligible for one single family residence and accessory structures.
- 3. Per Section 11.0 of the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance, the following standards are to be considered when deciding a zoning change:

- 1. The petition is consistent with the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan and the comprehensive plan of any Town affected by said petition.
- 2. Adequate public facilities and services (including sewage and waste disposal, water, gas, electricity, schools, police and fire protection, and roads and transportation, as applicable) will be available as required by the petition while maintaining adequate levels of service to existing development.
- 3. Provisions of public facilities to accommodate the petition will not place an unreasonable burden on the ability of affected local units of government to provide the.
- 4. The petition will not result in significant adverse impacts upon surrounding properties or the natural environment, including air, water, noise, stormwater management, soils, wildlife and vegetation.
- 5. The land associated with the petition is suitable for the proposed development and said development will not cause unreasonable soil erosion or have an unreasonable adverse effect on rare or irreplaceable natural areas.
- 6. The petition will not be used to legitimize a nonconforming use or structure.
- 7. The petition is the minimum action necessary to accomplish the intent of the petition, and an administrative adjustment, variance, or Conditional Use Permit could not be used to achieve the same result.
- 8. The petition will not result in illegal "spot zoning" (i.e. use is inconsistent with surrounding properties and serves only a private, rather than public interest).

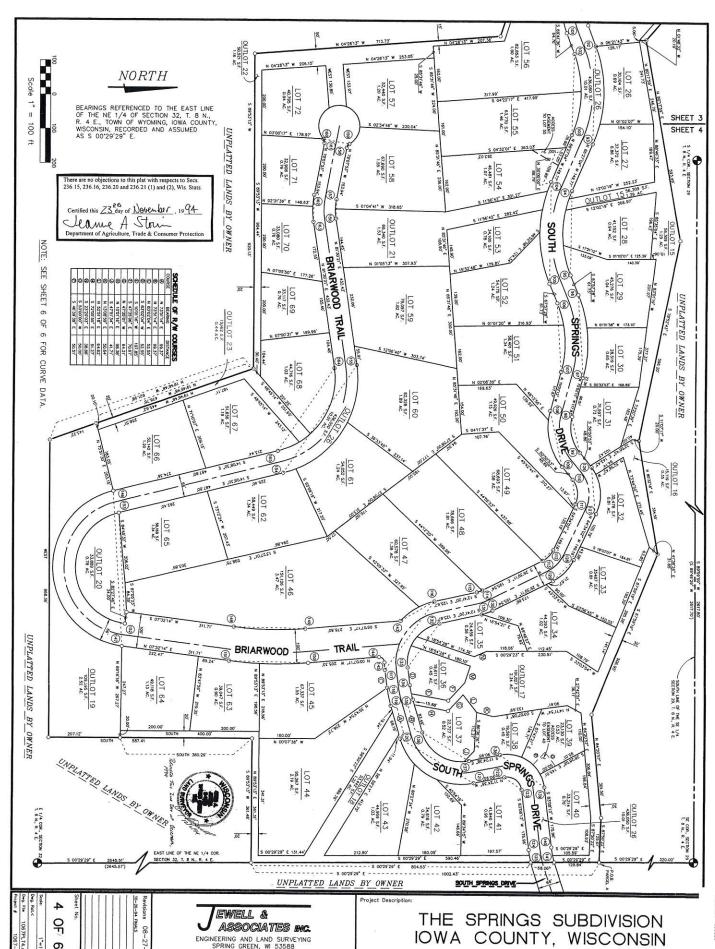

Request: This is a request to create a 8.96-acre lot by rezoning from A-1 Ag to AR-1 Ag Res and includes zoning 11.33 acres with the AC-1 overlay.

- 1. The proposed lot doesn't meet the minimum 40-acre lot size to remain A-1, the AR-1 district is being proposed. The AC-1 overlay is required to comply with the residential density standard in the Town of Brigham.

Request: This is a request to rezone 1.95 acres from A-1 Ag to AR-1 Ag Res and 40 acres with the AC-1 Ag Conservancy overlay to comply with residential density. Included is a CUP request for livestock type Animal Units on the 1.95 acres.



- The A-1 district has a minimum 40-acre lot size, so the proposed 1.95-acre lot is being petitioned to be zoned AR-1 Ag Res. Staff questions if the 1.95 acres is adequate for the total proposed animals unless contingent on an agreement for pasturing on adjacent land.





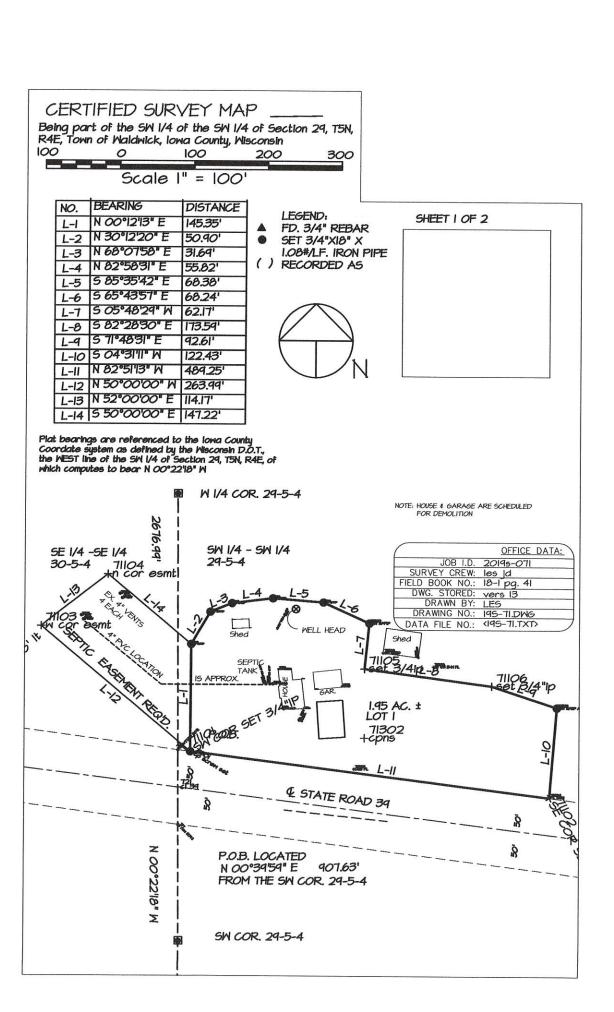

Agenda item: Consideration of request by Steven Sylvester and Linda Hilsenhoff to waive the after-the-fact zoning permit fees for two structures

Summary: The two structures at issue were found when reviewing the 2018 aerial photographs. Having found no record of the required zoning permits, a letter was sent to Mr. Sylvester and Ms. Hilsenhoff dated August 28, 2019 informing of the need for after-the-fact permits or removal of the structures.

Mr. Sylvester and Ms. Hilsenhoff replied by letter dated Sept. 8, 2019 stating the two structures were purchased from a local business where they were told permits were not required. Further, they stated the permit application only refers to construction or development and, since these are built structures moved to the property, they felt permits were not required.

Staff Recommendation: Although a call to the office could have prevented this situation and it is the ordinance provisions that control versus the way an application is worded, it is apparent this was an unintended violation. Similar requests to waive the after-the-fact portion of the fee have been approved in the past. The regular fees total \$300, which the applicants have paid. The after-the-fact fee would be an additional \$600. Staff would not object to a waiver.

Next steps: If the Committee chooses to recommend a waiver, action will be required by the full County Board.

To The Iowa County Planning & Zoning Committee:

We are seeking a waiver for the after-the-fact triple fees charged to us after we purchased two mobile storage sheds from Kate's Bait near Dodgeville and had them delivered to our lowa County residence without applying for a permit. We were told by the dealer who has been selling them for over six years that the sheds were personal property and did not require a permit. We now know this was misinformation. The fact that the dealer could remain misinformed for so long and sell so many sheds without any indication a permit is required, reveals a lack of clarity regarding permit requirements in lowa County. This is what we found when we consulted the lowa County zoning permit application packet (before placing our sheds) which contained vague and imprecise information.

At the top of the first page in bold type it says, "A Permit is required for almost any construction of or alteration to a structure..." To be clear and accurate the bold typed line should say, "A permit is required for almost any construction, placement or alteration of a structure..." On the first page it is also stated that, "failure to obtain the required county permit before starting construction is a citable violation," To be clear it should say that,

"failure to obtain the required county permit before constructing or locating a structure is a citable

violation." The exclusion of the words "placing" or "locating" makes these statements unacceptably and legally vague

and makes a big difference in how the ordinance is understood. Placing a portable (non-animal) structure on already occupied land is simply not addressed. There is not even a designated space on the permit application for placing or locating a structure on occupied land. When we eventually filled out the application, we had to cross out the question, "what are you building?" and replace it with, "what are you locating?" This is why after initially reviewing the zoning permit application packet we reasonably assumed we did not need a permit for rolling in two portable sheds.

Just as the focus of the application is on construction, so it is with the fee schedule which had a large heading above the after-the-fact fee section that stated, "after-the-fact fees apply for construction begun before a required permit is secured." We engaged in no construction and promptly paid our (single) fees in full according to the published fee schedule when notified that a permit was required. As of 1-14-20, the fee schedule has been changed and the heading removed. This is likely because we pointed out to Director Godfrey on 1-13-20 that his office is charging us after-the-fact fees that are not in accord with the fee schedule. He apologized for the confusion and said that he could make a revision for future applicants and to his credit he quickly did so. In our case though, it is only fair and legal that the fee schedule we received before-the-fact be honored and not changed

after-the-fact to collect triple fees.

We consulted the zoning permit application packet with the best intentions to determine the permit requirements in lowa County. Because these permit requirements were vaguely defined and not clearly conveyed we feel we were entrapped with punitive charges that were not even consistent with the established fee schedule. This is why we think it is only right to confer a waiver of the triple fees charged to us.

Agenda items: Consideration of request by Jennifer Thomas to waive the afterthe-fact zoning permit fee for an addition to a structure

Summary: The addition at issue was noticed by staff when in the area on Jan. 28, 2020. At that time, the addition had been mostly framed but not enclosed. A letter was sent to Ms. Thomas on Feb. 5, 2020 informing of the need for an after-the-fact permit. Ms. Thomas replied by phone on Feb. 10th stating a building was torn down and this addition is a replacement structure that she didn't realize needed a permit.

Ms. Thomas submitted an application with \$300 after-the-fact fee on Feb. 14^{th} and the permit was issued that same day. Ms. Thomas made this request for a waiver of the after-the-fact fee by email dated Feb. 25^{th} .

Staff Recommendation: Although a call to the office could have prevented this situation, similar requests to waive the after-the-fact portion of the fee have been approved in the past. Staff would not object to a waiver.

Next steps: If the Committee chooses to recommend a waiver, action will be required by the full County Board.

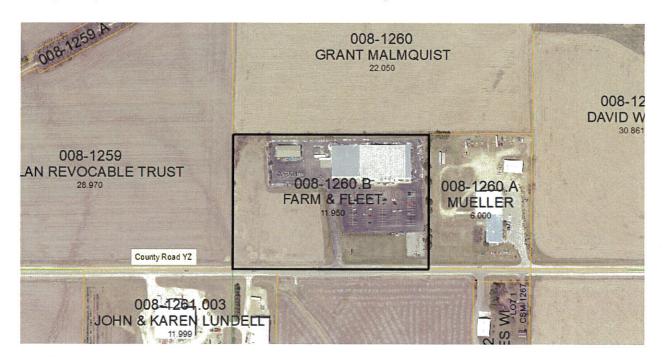
