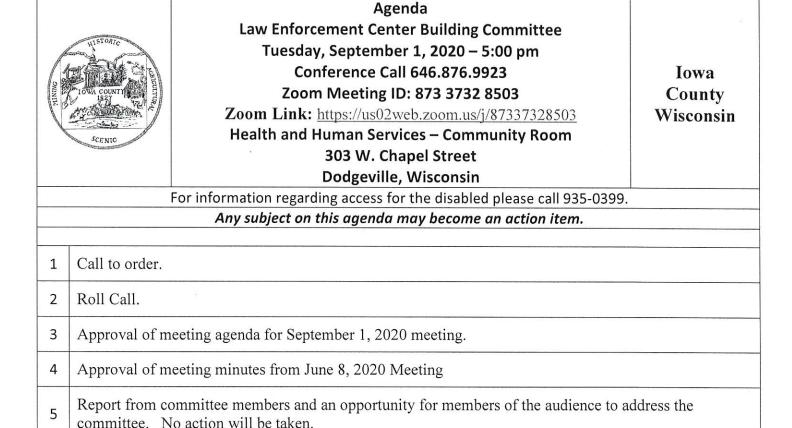
## NOTICE OF AN ELECTRONIC MEETING

County Administrator called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. Roll Call: Members Present: Joan Davis, Steve Deal, Curt Peterson, and Bruce Paull. Zoom: Supervisors Storti, and Meyers and Kassie Greenwood, Sheriff Steve Michek, Pam Steffes, Austin Durst, Keith Hurlbert, Dave Vandewater, Robert Keeney, and Larry Bierke. Absent: None Election of Chair: Bierke asked for nominations for Chair. Deal moved, Davis seconded to nominate Supervisor Peterson as Committee Chair. Meek moved, Davis seconded to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Supervisor Peterson. Motion carried. Election of Vice Chair: Meek moved, Davis seconded to nominate Supervisor Deal as Committee Vice Chair. Meek moved, Davis seconded to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Supervisor Deal. Motion carried. Election of Secretary: Deal moved, Meek seconded to nominate Supervisor Davis as Committee 5 Secretary. Deal moved, Davis seconded to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Supervisor Davis. Motion carried. Bond Sale: Finance Director Roxie Hamilton updated the Committee on the Law Enforcement Center bond sale. The bonds had a 1.93% composite interest rate for the sale. Initially the 6 expectation was closer to 3%, which would have costs \$3.3 million more in interest payments over the life of the loan. It was further reported that in order to keep the debt levy flat, the County would need to borrow \$1.3 million more in 2020. Berm Construction: One way to dispose of the spoils on the construction site is to construct a berm along the highway 18 side of the site. Said berm would cost just over \$31,000 to construct. Davis 7 moved, Meek seconded to not build the berm along highway 18 and save the \$31,000. Motion carried. Construction Update: Dave Vandewater gave a construction update, handed out an updated construction schedule. About 3 weeks ahead of schedule. 3/4 of foundation on the sheriff's offices and starting sally port next week. Electrical is all in. Starting Concrete Block work in 3 weeks and structural steel arriving in a couple of weeks. Pushing hard to get ahead of schedule while weather is good. Planning to update the schedule monthly to keep all informed. Distributed a copy of the Kramer Brothers COVID19 Policy. There is a \$50,000 rock allowance and so far, we have used it all. Removed 500 yards of hard rock so far. Shallower rock we are able to rip with the rock bucket, so we are not anticipating an extra for rock. Dave went over the subcontractor meeting schedule planned for 2 hours every other Wednesday. Owner Architect meeting occurs monthly.

9	Building Construction Process for Changes: The Committee discussed what types of approvals would be needed for cost over-runs or change orders. Meyers noted that it was important to have guidelines and parameters that the Committee is comfortable with. Davis moved, Meek seconded to approval authority of \$20,000 for the County Administrator or County Board Chair or Committee Chair Peterson, \$50,000 for the Committee, and anything over that would go to the County Board. Motion carried.
10	Appoint a Representative from the Committee: Owners meetings are scheduled for the 4 <sup>th</sup> Wednesday at 9:30 AM. The Committee decided that Peterson would be the first rep, Deal the second rep, and Davis would be the 3 <sup>rd</sup> back up Committee member attending the Owners meetings.
11	Next Meeting Date: As needed and set by Committee Chair
12	Adjourn: Deal moved, Paull seconded to adjourn. Motion carried at 5:43 PM.
