Meeting was called to order by Chair Dave Gollon at 1:01 pm.

Roll Call. Members present: Rod Anding (via Zoom), Ron Benish, Bob Bunker, Kevin Butteris, Dave Gollon, Don Leix, and Dan Nankee. Members absent: Roger Dax Others present: Katie Abbott, Landon Baumgartner (via Zoom), Mayme Keagy (via Zoom), Steve Holmes (via Zoom), Laurie Makos (via Zoom).

Approve the agenda for this January 20, 2021 meeting: Sup. Nankee made a motion to approve this January 20, 2021 agenda. Sup. Benish seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approve the minutes of the December 16, 2020 meeting: Mr. Bunker made a motion to approve the December 16, 2020 minutes. Sup. Leix seconded the motion. Motion carried.

NRCS update: no update was provided

Issues with public hunting at Bloomfield Prairie- Peter Vanderloo: Sup. Gollon shared an email received from Peter Vanderloo about public driving on the Bloomfield Prairie property. Steve Holmes joined to discuss the concerns of the Iowa County Prairie Restoration and Recreation group. Staff is working on an ordinance proposal and will involve the two non-profit renters in the process.
