1	Call to order. The February 21, 2022 meeting was called to order by Chairman Gollon at 6:00 p.m.	
2	Roll Call. Present at roll call: Supervisors: Steve Deal, Dave Gollon, Mel Masters, Jeremy Meek, Mike Peterson, and Sue Storti. Supervisor Jeremy Meek joined the meeting via telephone at 6:02 p.m. Others Present: Supervisor John Meyers, Larry Bierke and Craig Hardy. Others Present via Zoom: Supervisor Joan Davis, Katie Abbott, and Jamie Gould.	
3	Consent Calendar A. Approve February 21, 2022 Agenda B. Approve October 27, 2021 Minutes Motion by Sup. Deal seconded by Sup. Masters to approve consent calendar for the February 21, 2022 agenda and approve the October 27, 2021 minutes. Motion carried.	
4	Report from committee members and an opportunity for members of the audience to address the committee. No action will be taken. Sup. Masters requested Hardy to provide the committee with an update on the airport funding. Iowa County Airport is being awarded \$1.73 million over the next 5 years for airport improvements. Sup. Davis has been receiving questions from the public about what we are going to do with the old jail and Bloomfield buildings.	
5	2022 Capital Improvement Plan and Modifications thereof Bierke reviewed the staff recommendations for the 2022 CIP. Discussion followed. Motion by Sup. M. Peterson seconded by Sup. Masters to approve staff recommendations, which include changes to items H-K, C, D and additions 1, 2, 3, 4 and apply leftover money to 6. Motion carried.	
6	Determine Future of Sheriff's Office/Jail and Nursing Home Building Bierke and Sup. Meyers met with Southwest Technical College (SWTC) regarding the site of Sheriff's Office/Jail. Iowa County would donate the land to the Southwest Technical College Foundation. SWTC would construct a building to hold commercial space on first floor which would be occupied by SWTC and residential apartments on second floor. The cost to Iowa County to raze the building is approximately \$75k.	

	Motion by Sup. Deal seconded by Sup. Masters to get an appraisal for the property, start decommissioning and demolition of the building and continue discussions with Southwest Technical College. Motion carried. Bierke asked the committee for ideas on the future nursing home building. Discussion followed. No action was taken.
