7. Aging & Disability Resource Center & County Aging Unit Reports-

- a) Dana Harcus, ADRC, and Lafayette County:
- -Part D open enrollment postcards.
- -Transportation driver up and going.
- -Transportation application due by the end of the year.
- -Vaccine grant, in-home or on site.
- -Grandpa and Lucy Play coming to the counties, early November. Goal to promote awareness of dementia
- **b)**Valerie Hiltbrand from ADRC in Iowa County:
- -Medicare Prescription Drug Enrollment is October 15th-December 6th.
- -Elder Benefit Specialist held a Medicare 101 presentation.
- -Health and Wellness Expo is Friday September 30th.

8. Monthly Reports

- Haakenson released the following numbers:

a) Cash Flow

- -Checking account balance was \$50,890.49 as of August 25th, 2022. Total expenses (Vouchers) \$58,333.49 plus current bank balance 91,561.13, leaves \$33,227.64 as of today.
- -This is with our Additional line of Credit of \$25,000.
- -Out of checks, so have board member come in to sign checks from Farmer's Savings Bank
- -Lafayette Manor just sent a bill for 4 months, McManus tried to contact, but no response.
- -Village of Argyle gives monthly \$150.00.
- -Funds in site bank accounts have not been transferred yet; do monthly.
- **b) Budget Reports**: No profit & Loss report.

c) Monthly Participation Numbers

- -Receiving calls for participation, but they trend to the home delivery area.
- -Congregate 460 Meals in 2021 and 213 for 2022.
- -Participate donations are up slightly; both Lafayette/Iowa averages over \$4.00 per meal.
- -Lafayette participation numbers are still lower than 2021.
- -Food Share funds are up.
- -Dodgeville is the largest site.
- -Congregate numbers are down, working on getting those up. Take-outs; we are encouraging them to come to the site. GWAAR is discouraging take-out.
- -Full cost meals are way up, collections of these funds are challenging.
- -Mom's Meals have been doing some local deliveries in our area through Medicare funds.
- -Marion made a motion to place monthly reports on file and 2nd by Boyle.

9. County Levy for 2023-Update

- -Recap; McManus requested additional \$30,000 from each county for 2023.
- -Lafayette funding request thru Human Services; Iowa County may be 3rd increase in 9 years.
- -Heard from Iowa County that we will not receive the requested amount.
- -Funding from GWAAR delayed by months; it's hard to have a cash flow.

10. GWAAR change -Update-

- -McManus states that were are working on it and how 2023 will look.
- -Nikki Mumm, from Iowa County working with Kelly on some financial things.
- -Dana Harcus, Lafayette County, coming on Oct 5th to shadow.
- -Slaney, is looking for the clarification on how the program works.
- -Slaney asked if board has policies in place for numbers of participation that we serve.

11. 2023 Budget - Discussion

- Sun Budged was discussed in the HHS meeting by Nankee.
- -Very preliminary and unsure of allocations.
- -2% raise for employees.
- -Raw food up slightly/more what is available; many substitutions.
- -Food transportation increase/driving to Platteville daily for Dodgeville/Linden

- -Consumables have gone up, especially foil pans.
- -Income from GWAAR is \$175,000 depending on contract from the state.
- -O'Brien mentioned that the cans for donation at the congregate site could be more visible.
 - -2023 budget shows a \$15,000 deficit.

12. Staff/Site Issues/Reports

a) Shullsburg - Status of Manager

-Paula Van Lent fell and broke shoulder; Benton had been doing Shullsburg meals since the end of July, going well.

b) Linden - Status of Manager

- -Eunice Naeger off since August 19th, for medical reasons. Karen, the other manager, has been covering and also going well.
- -Kathy Kay, Darlington site closed due to covid for a few days.

13. Grant Update

a) Community Foundation of Southern Wisconsin

- -Nothing new to report; Grants done for the year.
- **b) Other Grants** available to apply October 1st for Jenny Olson grant.
- -Will be asking for new computer & mileage.
