Alliant/WP&L prefers to install plastic pipes because the lifespan is longer than steel. RTC Counsel Eileen Brownlee reviewed the permit and stated she did not see an issue with WP&L having a variance based on expressed need, as long as they included the statement that they will reinstall it to Trans 29 standards if rail were to return.

Honer stated the Temporary Access Permit is required because Alliant's contractor is using the PRTC's property for storage and staging.
