| 5 | Report from committee members and an opportunity for members of the audience to address the committee. No action will be taken. |
| 6 | Iowa County Hazardous Materials Response Team Activities: Push to enlist Technicians, DeSoto Train derailment, April Training - decon. K. Hurlbert reported that at a recent WEM Regional meeting the State has been made aware of the need for recruitment of technicians and some of the obstacles. 4 members responded to the train derailment in DeSoto. One rail car was loaded with lithium batteries, a short video of what can happen if a damaged A battery were to have contact with water was played. The team also had a training on decon using the battery-operated sprayer in April. |
| 7 | Review Spill Reports: K. Hurlbert reviewed spill reports with the committee. Milk spill semi tanker at the round-about in Dodgeville, tanker overturned with milk in Town of Highland, Manure runoff into stream – Hollandale, Hydraulic Oil spill – City of Mineral Point, Unknown Clay colored substance – Town of Dodgeville, Milk Spill ongoing since January – Town of Dodgeville, DNR is monitoring. |
| 8 | Annual Site visits to reporting facilities. K. Hurlbert reported that 7 of the 8 reporting facilities site visits have been completed. Waiting on a meeting with Walnut Hollow to complete theirs. |
| 9 | Review & Approve Strategic Plan. Motion by Sup. M. Peterson to approve Strategic Plan. Seconded by B. Cushman. Motion carried. |
| 10 | 2023 Integrated Preparedness Planning Process (IPP): SWWRPC Survey & results and review of potential priorities. K. Hurlbert reviewed the IPP process with the committee. This will be a 4-year plan that encompasses emergency services, public, local government, and businesses. The survey was completed by SWWRPC for 6 counties in our region and results were compiled and sent to the counties. EM went through 10 years of After-Action Surveys to obtain a list of recommended improvements and training along with the recommendations from the Hazard Mitigation Plan that was completed last year. K. Hurlbert reviewed the survey findings with the committee. The survey results will be presented to the Emergency Services Committee in July. At the next LEPC meeting priorities will be set and planning will begin for the next 4 years. |
