Amendatory Ordinance No. 3-0125 to zone two lots of 1.21 and 2.01 acres from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential in the Town of Highland.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 4-0125 to zone 3.94 acres from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential and 8.864 acres from A-1 Agricultural and B-2 Highway Business to AR-1 Agricultural Residential in the Town of Ridgeway.

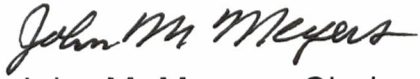
Mileage and Per Diem Report for this January 21, 2025 Session of the County Board was presented.

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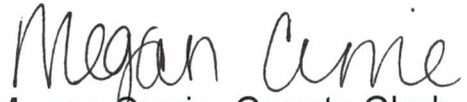
Motion by Sup. Nankee seconded by Sup. Lease to approve. Motion carried unanimously.
