- 3. - 7. Aging & Disability Resource Center & County Aging Unit Reports- a.)
 Hiltbrand stated ADRC is continuing to make plans for virtual programs for 2021, including prevention, caregiver, and Medicare Made Clear amonst other things. There is a statewide registry of virtual caregiver programs. They decided to postone the health Literacy Presentation about finding Health Information you can trust online. This will be just one session on March 30th. Aging Plan: They are starting to survey Iowa county residents to gather information in order to develop goals for the 2022-2024 Aging Unit Plan. Driver Escort: Busy and
