 Meeting Called to Order at 12:36 by Chairman Dan Nankee at Darlington Municipal Building, 627 Main Street, Darlington, WI 53530.

2. Roll Call-

- 3. Certification of Compliance with Open Meeting Law Loop stated, that on September 9, 2021, the agenda was posted at the HHS building and Emailed to the Dodgeville Chronicle and Lafayette Republican Journal. Also emailed to Iowa and Lafayette County Clerks. Chairmen Nankee requested the records show that the meeting was properly posted.

 - 7. Aging & Disability Resource Center & County Aging Unit Reports-a.)

 Schroeder states that all COVID-19 vaccination-interested parties over 65 can call LC Heatlh Dept at 776-4895 or fill out an online form for MHLC. 84% of those over age of 65 have been fully vaccinated; 61% of the total county population (18 and over) has been fully vaccinated as of 9/15/21. They have also been offering rides for folks to get their vaccines. Effective Monday, Sept 13, and at this point, HSD will be strongly encouraging public or other individuals coming into County K building to wear masks. Ann Reuter, the DBS, has resigned her position and her last day will be on Sept 24. Kay Schulte, our EBS, is gearing up for Medicare Part D enrollment, which begins on Oct 15 and runs through Dec 7.b.)Hiltbrand stated the HeART Coalition held an outdoor celebration on 9/16/21 to highlight the accomplishments of the coalition. - 9. Staff/Site Issues/Reports- a) Dodgeville Manager position-We hired a new Manager at Dodgeville, Patricia Christie; she has had a lot of previous food service experience. Bruce Paull and Donna Paull, volunteers, have worked a lot and the plan is to give them some time off. Joan Davis and Paige Grimm are volunteer drivers who will take the Monday route. There was a question about the six month probation period; we will place on the agenda for next month.
- 10. Budget Discussion- McManus stated the food contracts will probably not be in until November. Meat prices are up, as well as other food costs and mileage and stipends are also higher. NO information on GWAAR contracts. Recent raises for managers amount to about 15% increase. Will consider 2% raise for staff.
- **11. Grant Update- a.) Community Foundation of Southern WI: Benton-** we will get the \$2,500requested toward new dishwasher. Duwi grant is due at the end of December. **b.)Other Grants-** We will apply for Jenny Olsen, October 1, 2021.
