1. Call to Order

Due to Chairman Torkelson being excused, the meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Vice-Chair Flannery.

- Green County ATV reported it has been a relatively quiet month and helped at Green County Rural Safety day educating ~230 kids about ATV/UTV safety.
