Iowa County meals are up 70% over last year. Grandma's Kitchen was the meal provider in Highland for almost ten years. They have sold the business and the new owners have not replied yet to McManus' request that they be a meal provider. In the meantime, Ss. Anthony & Philip Church will continue as the dining site and will be the meal provider for the time being.
