7. Discussion and Action on Wisconsin Power and Light Utility Crossing Application in Clarno Township, Green County, WI – *Honer*.

Honer stated he reviewed the utility crossing and that it follows the Trans. 29 standard that the Commission follows. He then introduced Pete Chen from Wisconsin Power and Light. Chen stated that they are retiring an overhead service that has been in service for around seventy years. Chen stated that the overhead line will be replaced with an underground service. Pete stated that the work is also part of Alliant Energy's aggressive schedule to standardize the system. Chen stated there will be no tree clearing.

Olson asked how deep the utility will be placed. Chen stated it will be 15 feet below the base of the trail. Beach asked if Alliant is instigating the project, Chen stated that it is Alliant's project and believes that it is their project, not the landowners. Beach asked what is required to have a replacement line, if another landowner wanted their service placed underground. Chen stated that Alliant

has an internal schedule to replace lines based on an improvement plan and age of the existing power line. Beach asked what the minimum requirement is to replace a line and that he is surprised that Alliant is doing the investment. Pete said that he doesn't know the requirements for a replacement but that some of the lines in the area, such as this one, are very old. Chen also stated that while some of the lines are old, they are still in good condition and do not requirement replacement. Chen stated he was not aware of the condition that this line is in.
