1	Chair Meek called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.
2	Roll Call. Members present: Supervisors Haag, Meek, and Richter. Meyers filled in for Leix. - Others Present: County Administrator Larry Bierke, Supervisor Deal, Sheriff Michek, and Mike Peterson. - Others On Zoom: Keith Hurlbert, Deb Rosenthal, and Austin Durst. -Absent: Supervisor Leix and Ray.
3	Meeting Agenda: Richter moved, Haag seconded to approve the agenda for April 6, 2021. Motion carried.
4	Meeting Minutes: Haag <u>moved</u> , Meyers seconded to approve the meeting minutes for October 27, 2020. Motion Carried
5	Reports: Meyers thanked Bierke for meeting testifying at the Capital this morning on a transportation bill.
6	<u>Financial Statements</u> : The Committee reviewed the year-end financial statement for 2020. Bierke answered questions from the committee.
7	<u>Child Support Annual Report</u> : The report was included in the packet. 2020 Revenue exceeded expectations for 2020. Rosenthal noted that the TRIP program intercepted COVID money going to clients.
8	<u>Update on LEC Construction</u> : Sheriff Michek encouraged tours of the building project. Ceilings are being installed now and some carpeted rooms will be done shortly. Also discussed the sky lights and policy planning efforts.
9	Sheriff's Department Staffing update: Mike Peterson was appointed to fill the Jail Administrator position. There are two Dispatcher/Correctional staff starting later this month. Also in the process of hiring a patrol position. There are three internal staff members who have accepted Dispatcher positions.
10	Pandemic Response and Vaccination update: Hurlbert reported that 30% of Iowa County have been vaccinated. He expects that number to reach 41% by the end of the week. Staff are currently doing two vaccination clinics per week and typically handle 300 doses per week. Roughly 5,000-6,000 residents left to vaccinate. He is still meeting with School Superintendents once per month and he noted that he has been doing quite a few media interviews lately.
9	Next Meeting: was set for May 4, 2021 at 6 PM. – If needed.
10	Adjourn: Haag moved, Richter seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried at 6:54 PM.
