**A RESOLUTION SEEKING WCA AND STATE OF WISCONSIN
SUPPORT IN CYBER SECURITY PREVENTION**

WHEREAS, there have been frequent cyberattacks against counties in the State of Wisconsin the past few years; and

WHEREAS, counties have limited resources due to levy caps, and limited net new construction; and

WHEREAS, counties are shielded in a shroud of secrecy, unable to problem solve with other counties during a cyberattack and are forced to work alone; and

WHEREAS, there is strength with numbers when counties and agencies work together collaboratively; and

WHEREAS, cyber protection services are very expensive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors encourages the Wisconsin Counties Association and the State of Wisconsin to provide response protocols, a more robust training program, and support for the prevention of such attacks. These actions would include, but are not limited to, pooling resources for protective software and instruction on prevention.
