SUBJECT: **FY18-21 CIP Budget: Mid-Year Update and Bi-annual Submission to the City of Livermore's AB1600 Spend Plan**

COMMITTEE: Facilities Committee Recommended Approval in its 2/21/19 meeting

RECOMMENDATION: That the Finance Committee recommends that the Board of Directors approve the District's Mid-Year update to its FY18-21 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) budget.

BACKGROUND: At mid-year, the District reassesses its Approved three-year CIP Budget and presents proposed revisions to the Board of Directors for approval. Before reviewing with the Board, proposed revisions are reviewed by the Facilities Committee, whose guidance is then reflected in a subsequent review with the Finance Committee. Feedback from both committees is reflected in a Board Budget Workshop and Board of Directors meeting, which, this year, are scheduled for March 13, 2019.

1. **Attachment A** provides a summary of the District's updated plans for CIP spending versus the Approved Budget, including all funding sources.
2. Every two years, the City of Livermore, with whom the District shares AB1600 funds, updates its CIP Budget; LARPD's plans for AB1600 fund usage are incorporated in the City's bi-annual budgeting process.
 - a. **Attachment B** provides an updated view of LARPD's planned use of AB1600 funds, including spending plans for current projects that are consistent with Attachment A.
 - b. A note re: Funding Sources
 - i. AB1600: developer fees shared by the District and the City of Livermore – to be used for public parks and intended for capital improvement programs in response to development projects that will impact service levels for public infrastructure, which includes, but is not limited to, Park and Recreation infrastructure. AB1600 allows for reimbursement of costs incurred to address increased demand for public facilities reasonably attributed to development

projects in order to: a) refurbish existing facilities to maintain the existing level of service, or b) achieve an adopted level of service that is consistent with the City's General Plan.

- ii. General Fund
 - 1. Committed reserve funds that are targeted for CIP initiatives that do not meet the criteria for AB1600 or other funding sources (targeted funds such as grants and trusts).
- iii. Trusts and Grants
 - 1. Typically establish specific spending guidelines for use (e.g., Buckley Trust).
