

SOLID WASTE FEE SCHEDULE
EFFECTIVE
AS PER RESOLUTION 25-

RESIDENTIAL

Customers with a solid waste sticker may dispose of up to 3 yards of household waste per day at no charge, any overage will be charged at the posted commercial rates. Bonner County residential customers without a sticker may pay \$5.00 to dispose of up to 3 yards of household waste per day; over 3 yards will be charged the commercial rates. *** YOU MUST HAVE YOUR STICKER TO AVOID BEING CHARGED. NO ADDITIONAL STICKERS WILL BE AVAILABLE OTHER THAN WHAT YOU ARE MAILED.**

COMMERCIAL

Commercial customers will be charged by yardage based on posted fees. Residential stickers are not to be used for commercial trash.

Definition of household waste:

Household waste, or domestic waste, consists of the disposable materials generated in residences, including everyday items like food scraps, packaging, paper, glass and plastic, as well as larger items such as old furniture and mattresses. It also includes household hazardous waste(HHW), such as batteries, cleaning products and solvents that require special disposal to prevent harm to people and the environment.

Examples of household waste:

Food Waste-Vegetable peels, fruit rinds, meat and other organic food scraps.

Paper and Cardboard-Newspapers, magazines, packaging and boxes.

Plastics-Packaging, bottles, and other disposable plastic items.

Glass and metal-Jars, bottles, and food cans.

Textiles and clothing- Discarded clothes.

Garden Waste-Trimnings and other organic plant matter.

Bulky Items-Furniture, mattresses, and carpets and appliances.

Examples of household hazardous waste (HHW):

Batteries-lead-acid and other types of batteries

Chemicals-Cleaners, solvents, pesticides, and herbicides.

Paints and automotive products-Leftover paints, motor oil and other fluids.
