The Bonner County Engineering Department is inviting interested architectural firms to submit their qualifications for architectural and engineering services to assist the County in design and construction of a new Treasurer's Office in the existing Suite 101 of the County Administration Building. The Architect selected will work with the County to develop design documents and oversee construction of a new Treasurer's Office and remodel an existing office area for relocation of the GIS department. The proposed project site is located at 1500 Highway 2, Sandpoint, Idaho.

This Request for Qualifications does not commit the County to award a contract, to pay any cost incurred in the preparation of the submittal, or to procure or contract for services. The County reserves the right to negotiate with all qualified respondents, or to cancel in part or in its entirety this Request for Qualifications, if it is in the best interest of the County to do so.

BACKGROUND

Bonner County intends to relocate four departments located within the Bonner County Administration Building to other areas of the building. This project requires office planning, remodeling, and coordination to effectively relocate these departments with minimal disruption to public services.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. The selected Architect(s) will be required to perform the architectural and engineering services to be specified more fully in a contract agreement and to be negotiated after selection. The contract agreement will provide for payment for phases of work completed with options to proceed through all phases or to discontinue work as the circumstances may dictate. Upon selection of a firm with whom negotiations will proceed, a Scope of Work will be developed. However, the County reserves the right to include additional project elements in the initial or subsequent professional services agreements as the County may (in its sole discretion) deem appropriate. The Architect will also be required to identify and select the appropriate sub-consultants; however, the County reserves the right to approve proposed sub-consultants that will be associated with the Project.

The Architect will coordinate and cooperate fully with the County Project Manager and Engineering Department as necessary during the project design and construction. Initial planning phase cost estimates will be provided by the selected Architect.

Responses to this RFQ must include the following:

- 1. Firm's name, address, telephone and email addresses;
- 2. The experience and qualifications of staff to be assigned to the project;
- A description of the firm's prior experience, including up to (3) similar projects, location, total cost, and name of a local official knowledgeable regarding the firm's performance;

- 5. Proposed work plan and schedule of activities.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection committee shall be comprised of the Director Public Works, the Manager of the Engineering Department and may include select members of County staff. Submittals will be evaluated and ranked with the following weighted criteria:

1.	Qualifications of professional personnel to be assigned to project	30%
2.	Related experience on similar projects	30%
3.	Capability to meet time and project budget requirements	20%
4.	Present and projected workloads	10%
5.	Consulting firms location	10%

If the shortlist established via the above ranking includes more than one firm, the Selection Committee may request a presentation and interview from the shortlist of prospective consultants. The award will be made to the most qualified firm whose RFQ submission and interview (if applicable) is deemed most advantageous to the County.

The applicants may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:

- The applicant is involved in litigation against the County;
- The applicant has other obligations which present a conflict of interest.





The referenced application is hereby administratively **approved with conditions** as of the date of this letter.

The applicant or interested parties had 10 days from the date of the issuance of the staff report to provide written comment in response. As of the date of this decision letter several comments have been received in response to this project in the ten-day comment period since the release of the staff report. Findings of Facts:

- 1. The site (parcel no. RP54N03W210650A) consists of approximately 70 acres of unplatted land, zoned Agricultural/Forestry 10.
- 2. The parcel has access to the Kelso Lake Road via Kelso Woods Drive, a County owned and privately maintained public right-of-way, per plat of Kelso Lake Woods subdivision, recorded on March 27, 1985 at Instrument No. 300775 in Bonner County records. The status of this road public or private has been contested in some of the public comments received in response to this project.
- The site has in indirect access to the Kelso Lake Road via Kelso Woods Drive. Kelso Lake
 Road is a County owned and maintained public right-of-way with a speed limit of 40 miles
 per hour and treated with gravel.
- 4. Site contains slopes of over 30% grade. Per BCRC 12-7.6, the applicant has submitted a geotechnical engineering report dated November 11, 2022, prepared by Jerry R. Weed, an Idaho state licensed engineer for improvements along Kelso Woods Drive and Lochlyn Lane, the proposed private road.
- 5. Site contains approximately 1500 lineal foot of an intermittent stream. It also contains PFO1C and PSS1C freshwater forested/ shrub mapped wetlands. The PSS1C freshwater forested/ shrub wetlands run along an intermittent stream through the subject site. The applicant submitted a professional wetland delineation prepared by T-O Engineers, dated May 24, 2022 at the time of application, per BCRC 12-7.3. Per BCRC 12-714.B, shoreline vegetation buffer management areas along the wetlands present on the site have been delineated on the proposed plat.
- 6. Site is not within floodway and is located within Special Flood Hazard Area X, per FIRM Panel 16017C1150E, effective November 18, 2009. This project would not require any further floodplain review.
- 7. No critical wildlife habitat areas on the site identified by any local, state or federal agencies.

- 8. The proposed lots will be served by individual wells, individual septic systems and Northern Lights, Inc. The site is located within Timberlake Fire District, Lake Pend Oreille School District #84, Pend Oreille Hospital District and Bonner County Ambulance District.
- 9. The proposed preliminary plat has been evaluated as per the applicable Bonner County Revised Code standards, subject to Conditions of Approval. See staff review above and the conditions of approval below.

Conclusions of Law:

Based upon the findings of fact, the following conclusions of law are adopted:

- **Conclusion 1:** The proposed subdivision **is** in accord with the purposes of this Title and of the zoning district in which it is located.
- **Conclusion 2:** The site **is** physically suitable for the proposed development.
- **Conclusion 3:** The design of the proposed subdivision **will not** adversely impact Bonner County's natural resources, as identified in the comprehensive plan. Any adverse impacts or potential for impacts shall be **mitigated** as a condition of approval.
- Conclusion 4: The public and private services, including but not limited to water, sewer services, solid waste, fire protection, emergency services, and school facilities and transportation, which will serve the proposed subdivision are adequate for the needs of future residents or users.
- Conclusion 5: The proposed subdivision will not cause circumstances to exist that will cause future residents or the public at large to be exposed to hazards to health or safety.
- Conclusion 6: The design of the proposed subdivision or related improvements will provide for coordinated access with the county system of roads and with adjacent properties and will not impede the use of public easements for access to, or through the proposed subdivision. The proposed transportation system is designed to adequately and safely serve the future residents or users without adversely impacting the existing transportation system by reducing the quality or level of service or creating hazards or congestion.
- **Conclusion 7:** The proposed subdivision is designed to comply with the design criteria for subdivisions set forth in Subchapter 6.2 of this chapter.
- **Conclusion 8:** The proposed subdivision **is** in accord with the Bonner County Comprehensive Plan.

Conditions of Approval:

1. The parcel has access to the Kelso Lake Road via Kelso Woods Drive, a County owned and privately maintained public right-of-way, per plat of Kelso Lake Woods subdivision, recorded on March 27, 1985 at Instrument No. 300775 in Bonner County records. The status of this road – public or private – has been contested in some of the public comments received in response to this project. The status of this road, thus, remains unclear. The applicant, therefore, shall request for validation of Kelso Woods Drive as a public right-of-way from the Board of County Commissioners through a process of public hearing as instructed by Idaho

State Code Title 40, Chapter 2 General Provisions, Sections 40-203A Validation of County or Highway District System Highway or Public Right-of-Way, prior to the submission of final plat.

- 2. Per BCRC 12-624.B, the proposed private road shall be constructed to private road standards set forth in Appendix A of BCRC Title 12. The applicant submitted road design plans and storm water management plans dated September 29, 2022 prepared by Kyle B. Cotton, an Idaho state licensed engineer. The applicant also submitted a road maintenance declaration with an exhibit of the legal description of the premises. These improvement plans for the private road and storm water management were approved by Bonner County per review memo dated October 12, 2022. The applicant shall also comply with any subsequent modification of these plans approved by Bonner County upon further review of the project, if needed.
- 3. Upon review of the validation request for Kelso Woods Drive by the Board of County Commissioners, if the road is validated as a public right-of-way, the applicant is required to make improvements to the road per Bonner County Road and Bridge Department's memo dated October 07, 2022 if Kelso Woods Drive is validated as a public right-of-way by the Board of County Commissioners. The applicant shall also comply with any subsequent modification made to these comments by the Bonner County Road and Bridge Department upon further review of the project, if needed.
- 4. Upon review of the validation request for Kelso Woods Drive by the Board of County Commissioners, if Kelso Woods Drive is not validated as a public right-of-way, the applicant shall submit to the Bonner County Planning Department plans for improvement of Kelso Woods Drive in compliance with Bonner County Revised Code, Title 12, Appendix A Private Road Standards.
- 5. Per BCRC 12-642.B.11, the proposed plat shall include a statement setting forth the intended land use of the parcels, i.e., residential, agricultural, commercial, industrial or other appropriate land use classifications.
- 6. Per BCRC 12-644.A, an improvements plan for the subdivision shall be submitted after the approval of the preliminary plat. The contents of the plan shall include the following:
 - a. The subdivision name and number, geographic grid (township, range and tier, section number and location within the section), north arrow, date and scale no smaller than one hundred feet to the inch (1" = 100").
 - b. The plan and profile of all proposed roads showing final grades and cross sections of roads in accord with the requirements contained in title 2 of this code.
 - c. The plan and profile of proposed sanitary and stormwater systems with grades and sizes indicated. Drain calculations may be required.
 - d. A grading plan, showing stormwater drainage for each lot.
 - e. Any other improvements such as curbs, gutters, sidewalks, bridges, lift stations, fire hydrants, streetlighting, etc., as required, and in accord with the requirements contained in BCRC Title 2.
- 7. Per BCRC 12-644.B, applicant's engineer shall provide inspection reports for County Engineer's review and final inspections.

- 8. Per BCRC 12-644.C, in lieu of completing all improvements as required before final plat recording, the subdivider shall enter into a surety agreement with the board agreeing to complete the improvements in accordance with surety agreement conditions and preliminary and final plat approvals. A cash deposit, certificate of deposit, corporate surety bond written by an insurance company licensed in Idaho having a rating from AM Best & Company of "A" or better, letter of credit issued and backed by a federal or state chartered bank, is required equivalent to one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the project engineer's estimated cost of construction of the improvements for the purpose of guaranteeing completion of the work and repair of any defects in improvements which occur within one year of the first acceptance of the completed work by the board. Sureties guaranteeing the work and repair of any defects in improvements which occur within one year after first acceptance of the completed work by the board may be reduced by the board by one-half (1/2) for that one year. The surety agreement shall be valid for a period not to exceed two (2) calendar years from the date of approval. At any time prior to the expiration date of the surety agreement, the subdivider may make a written request to the planning director for a single extension of the surety agreement for a period up to two (2) years. The board may consider such request for extension at any regular business meeting. The extension request must be approved or denied by the board prior to the expiration date of the surety agreement.
- 9. Per BCRC 12-646, BCRC 12-647 and BCRC 12-648, a final plat shall be submitted in accordance with these sections of the Bonner County Revised Code after the approval of the preliminary plat.
- 10. Per BCRC 12-648.A, the applicant shall submit final plat check fees, current preliminary title report and one blueprint copy of the proposed final plat. Instead of submitting one blueprint copy, the applicant may submit a pdf copy of the final blueline plat.
- 11. Per BCRC 12-648.B, final plat must conform to the final plat requirements of Idaho Code Section 50-1304 and BCRC 12-647.
- 12. Per BCRC 12-649, a digital copy of the final plat shall be submitted to the Planning Department. The digital copy submission shall not substitute for any contents of the final plat listed above.
- 13. Per BCRC 12-651.G, the preliminary short plat shall be valid for a period not to exceed two (2) calendar years from the date of approval. At any time prior to the expiration date of the preliminary short plat, an applicant may make a written request to the planning director for an extension of the preliminary short plat for a period up to two (2) years, finding that conditions or applicable regulations have not changed so substantially as to warrant reconsideration of the proposed subdivision with respect to the public health, safety, and general welfare. The planning director may recommend such request for extension at any regular business meeting of the board of commissioners. The extension request must be approved or denied prior to the expiration date of the preliminary short plat.
- 14. Per BCRC 12-7.2, the applicant submitted road design plans and storm water management plans prepared by Kyle B. Cotton, an Idaho state licensed engineer. The stormwater management plans were approved by Bonner County per review memo dated October 12, 2022. The applicant shall also comply with any subsequent modification of these plans approved by Bonner County upon further review of the project, if needed.
- 15. Per BCRC 12-7.6, the applicant has submitted a geotechnical engineering report dated November 11, 2022, prepared by Jerry R. Weed, an Idaho state licensed engineer for improvements along Kelso Woods Drive and Lochlyn Lane, the proposed private road. This report shall be reviewed by Bonner County in accordance with Bonner County Revised Code.

Modifications to the geotechnical analysis may be required upon review of the report. The applicant shall comply with these plans, if approved as submitted or with the subsequent modifications as determined by Bonner County.

NOTE: Any determination made by the Planning Director or his designee in the administration of this decision may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners by notifying the Planning Director in writing of the intent to appeal within ten (10) calendar days from the date of this determination. (BCRC 12-651.H).

Following any final decision concerning a site-specific land use request, the applicant has a right to request a regulatory taking analysis pursuant to Section 67-8003, Idaho Code (Idaho Code §67-6535(3)).

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LOCATION OF **PROJECT** KELSO WOODS DRIVE -NEAR ATHOL, ID VICINITY MAP

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
