

SUMMARY

Performs a variety of professional and administrative level Human Resources (HR) /Risk Management duties in a strict confidential setting. and may carry out responsibilities in some or all of the following functional areas: risk management claims tracking and payments, workers compensation, and benefits administration and billing. Performs HR Risk related duties including specialized project work and to answer inquiries and provide information to County employees regarding personnel policies, practices, and procedures. Work includes accepting, processing, and maintenance of employee forms and other personnel documents, and explaining federal and state laws, job requirements, personnel policies, and benefits. Ability to assist and perform work related to all aspects of HR Risk management as needed or requested. The work is performed with limited supervision under the general direction of the Human Resources Director (HRD) and Risk Manager, with the ability to exercise independent judgment and initiative. The principal duties of this class job are performed in a general office environment.

Work is typically regular and recurring, involving some degree of complexity where good judgment is required to apply standard practices and decision making within clearly established guidelines. Works independently but under the supervision of the department Human Resources Director (HRD). Communicates with others throughout the organization and with the general public. Work has a distinct impact on the operations of the department and other departments throughout the County. Work involves a variety of confidential and sensitive information. Work is typically performed in an office environment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The essential functions include, but are not limited to, the following duties and responsibilities which are not listed in any particular order of priority and may be amended or added to by the County at any time:

- Primary responsibility for workers compensation, and benefit administration.
- Provides information and responds to questions regarding personnel policies and procedures; A able to effectively communicate and guide managers and employees with personnel policies their application and practices. Knowledgeable of HR Policy and practice. Interprets and applies personnel policy, ensuring consistency and compliance. Makes recommendations for personnel policy changes.
- Responsible for monthly ACA tracking and annual IRS reporting as well as annual nondiscrimination testing.
- Manages the employee wellness program. Processes incentive contributions, premium discounts and eligibility.
- Works closely with the Technology Department to test, troubleshoot and resolve reporting and system problems related to the Human Resources Information System (HRIS) and other systems.
- Processes and tracks employees who are on workers compensation. Works with assigned claims manager.
- Processes and tracks risk management claims.
- Supports the annual budget process with department heads and Elected Officials.
- Manages and maintains accurate budget sheets for all departments.
- Assists the HR Director with maintaining, analyzing, and implementing changes to the overall organizational compensation framework.
- Processes all employee status changes, including new hires, terminations, promotions, transfers, pay changes, etc.
- Collaborates with the HR Director in the creation and revision of policies and job descriptions.
- Advises employees regarding the county benefits program, including availability, family status changes, eligibility requirements, and new enrollment.
- Performs Supports duties related to benefits administration including, claims processing, billing and assisting newly benefit eligibility with enrollment.
- Assists with processing Short Term Disability applications and other voluntary benefits.
- Responsible for managing benefits administration via Employee Navigator, benefits admin system for Bonner County.
- Administrator for Think Zoom web-based education. Tracks all employee education at both the organizational and department level.
- Assists in coordination of annual open enrollment for health benefits.
- Oversight of HR Internet pages.
- Support benefits administration in the development and dissemination of communication and information materials on benefits plans, policies and procedures to promote employee benefits programs.
- Completes special projects assigned by the Human Resources Director HRD or Risk Manager.
- Maintains confidential employee personnel and functional files.
- Performs all duties under strict confidentiality requirements; Knowledge of and complies with HIPAA & Hitech privacy and security policies and regulations.

 Performs all work duties and activities in accordance with County policies, procedures, and safety practices.

SECONDARY FUNCTIONS

- Serves as a secondary point of contact for the administration of FMLA and other leaves.
- Works cooperatively and constructively with fellow workers and members of the public to provide public service of the highest quality and quantity;
- Comprehends, interprets and conveys to others the County's policies, practices, and procedures;
- Maintains records efficiently, accurately and confidentially and to prepare clear and concise reports;
- Establishes and maintains effective working relationships with elected and appointed officials, other County employees, supervisory personnel, insurance carriers, and the public;
- Operates standard office equipment, including a personal computer using program applications appropriate to assigned duties;
- Communicates effectively both orally and in writing; Excellent problem-solving abilities.
- Maintains strict confidentiality in all aspects of County Human Resources actions, records, practices, policies, and procedures; demonstrates a high regard for employee data and information under each Elected Official.
- Uses logical and creative thought processes and critical thinking skills to develop solutions according to written specifications and/or oral instructions.

JOB SPECIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree from a four-year college or university in Human Resources, Accounting, Finance, Communications or Business or a closely related field preferred; and a minimum of five (5) years related HR generalist recruitment experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Public sector HR experience preferred but not required.
- HR Generalist Certification is required within one year of employment.
- IMPA-HR, SPHR, PHR, SHRM-SCP, or SHRM-CP certificate preferred.
- Demonstrates exceptional professionalism and confidentiality
- Proficient with HRIS, Google, MS Office, PowerPoint, Web Based Internet/Intranet, File Management as well as Computer management.
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the knowledge and abilities necessary to perform the work.
- Background checks are conducted by Bonner County Sheriff's office.
- Must be able to pass a pre-employment background check.

SUMMARY

Under limited supervision, this position undertakes a diverse range of HR Human Resources (HR) related responsibilities, with a primary focus on coordinating recruitment to attract and secure top talent. Serving as the key resource for both internal and external applicants, the HR Generalist - TA acts as the initial point of contact for HR inquiries, including recruitment processes, employee orientation, and various employee-related functions.

The role involves performing regular and recurring duties that carry a moderate level of complexity, requiring sound judgment to apply established policies and make decisions within clearly defined guidelines. While working independently, the HR Generalist - TA operates under the guidance and direction of the Human Resources Director. This position requires effective communication and collaboration with individuals across the organization as well as with members of the public.

The work performed has a significant impact on departmental operations and influences cross-departmental functions throughout the County. The position frequently handles confidential and sensitive information, demanding the highest levels of discretion and professionalism. Typically, work is conducted in a professional office environment.

- Leads full-cycle recruitment and selection process, including developing compelling job announcements, strategically advertising vacancies, and identifying the most effective sourcing methods to attract high-quality, best-fit candidates for the organization.
- Collaborates closely with hiring managers to design and implement innovative, costeffective recruitment strategies tailored to attract top talent for high-level and hard-tofill positions, ensuring alignment with organizational goals and workforce planning initiatives.
- Conducts in-depth research and analysis of recruitment policies, practices, and emerging trends, while maintaining up-to-date knowledge of relevant laws, regulations, and best practices in human resources management. Utilizes this expertise to support departmental goals, enhance operational efficiency, and ensure compliance across HR functions within the County.
- Conducts comprehensive wage and salary analyses to ensure internal equity, market competitiveness, and alignment with organizational compensation strategies.
- Designs and develops engaging marketing and promotional materials to support recruitment efforts, while actively expanding and diversifying outreach channels and community partnerships. Monitors, analyzes, and optimizes advertising expenditures to maximize return on investment and reach targeted talent pools effectively.
- Provides critical support throughout the recruitment and selection process, including
 posting job openings and advertisements, managing application intake and tracking,
 responding to candidate inquiries, and ensuring a seamless and organized applicant
 experience through effective use of tracking systems.
- Manages employee separation process, including conducting exit interviews, ensuring timely completion of all required documentation, and accurately maintaining separation data to support compliance and organizational insights.
- Oversees Assists the Human Resources Director with the systematic development and ongoing revision of job descriptions to accurately reflect roles and responsibilities, while conducting comprehensive job evaluations to determine appropriate pay grades that align with internal equity and market competitiveness.

Conclusions of Law:

- **Conclusion 1:** The proposed subdivision **is** in accord with the purposes of this Title and of the zoning district in which it is located.
- **Conclusion 2:** The site **is** physically suitable for the proposed development.
- **Conclusion 3:** The design of the proposed subdivision **will not** adversely impact Bonner County's natural resources, as identified in the comprehensive plan. Any adverse impacts or potential for impacts shall be mitigated as a condition of approval.
- **Conclusion 4:** The public and private services, including but not limited to water, sewer services, solid waste, fire protection, emergency services, and school facilities and transportation, which will serve the proposed subdivision **are** adequate for the needs of future residents or users.
- **Conclusion 5:** The proposed subdivision **will not** cause circumstances to exist that will cause future residents or the public at large to be exposed to hazards to health or safety.
- Conclusion 6: The design of the proposed subdivision or related improvements will provide for coordinated access with the county system of roads and with adjacent properties and will not impede the use of public easements for access to, or through the proposed subdivision. The proposed transportation system is designed to adequately and safely serve the future residents or users without adversely impacting the existing transportation system by reducing the quality or level of service or creating hazards or congestion.
- **Conclusion 7:** The proposed subdivision is designed to comply with the design criteria for subdivisions set forth in Subchapter 6.2 of this chapter.
- **Conclusion 8:** The proposed subdivision **is not** in conflict with the Bonner County Comprehensive Plan.

Conditions of Approval:

- Per BCRC 12-623 (D): D. All proposed lots shall be designed by the applicant to provide a
 fire protection plan for the proposed lots to provide, at a minimum, an assessment of fire risk
 and plans to reduce the risk, and provisions for defensible space, where material capable of
 allowing a fire to spread unchecked will be treated, cleared or modified to slow the rate and
 intensity of an advancing wildfire and to create an area for fire suppression operations to
 occur, and for at least one of the following:
 - 1. Prior to final plat, an approved water and fire hydrant system capable of providing one thousand (1,000) gallons per minute for a minimum of two (2) hours where a community water system exists or is proposed as part of the development and is capable of delivering the pressurized water supply necessary for delivering fire flows as

prescribed by the international fire code, as adopted by the state fire marshal, and such later editions as may be so published and adopted by the state fire marshal, or as amended, modified or superseded, and incorporated herein by reference with a copy on file with the office of the clerk of the board of county commissioners, and hereinafter referred to as IFC.

- 2. A note on the final subdivision plat stating: "At the time of building location permit or building permit, the lot owner shall install a minimum two thousand (2,000) gallon water storage system, meeting IFC standards". Refill on demand is not required to meet IFC standards.
- 3. A note on the final subdivision plat stating: "The installation of an approved IFC residential fire suppression sprinkler system is required in all newly constructed residences".
- 4. Prior to final plat, a manmade or natural water source with a dry hydrant capable of delivering adequate water supply as prescribed by IFC.
- 5. A note on the final subdivision plat stating: "At the time of building permit or building location permit, the lot owner shall install an approved fire suppression method to the satisfaction of Bonner County"
- 2. Per BCRC 12-623 (B)(1), Lots to be served by an individual well on each lot: Applicants shall demonstrate how the aquifer proposed for water supply has sufficient production capability to provide drinking water to all applicable lots and that a location is available within each lot for installation of a well without conflicting with proposed sewage systems on or adjacent to the proposed lot.
- 3. Per BCRC 12-642 (B)(6), All FEMA flood hazard info to be shown.
- 4. Per BCRC 12-642 (B)(7), Existing well, sewers, wetland boundaries, structure, overhead utility lines/easements to be shown on plat.
- 5. Per BCRC 12-642 (B)(11), A statement of intended use to be included on plat.
- 6. Per BCRC 12-646, BCRC 12-647 and BCRC 12-648, a final plat shall be submitted in accordance with these sections of the Bonner County Revised Code after the approval of the preliminary plat.
- 7. Per BCRC 12-648 (A), the applicant shall submit final plat check fees, current preliminary title report and one blueprint copy of the proposed final plat. Instead of submitting one blueprint copy, the applicant may submit a pdf copy of the final blueline plat.
- 8. Per BCRC 12-648 (B), the final plat must conform to the final plat requirements of Idaho Code Section 50-1304 and BCRC 12-647.
- 9. Per BCRC 12-649, a digital copy of the final plat shall be submitted to the Planning Department. The digital copy submission shall not substitute for any contents of the final plat listed above.
- 10. Per BCRC 12-731 (A), A wetland reconnaissance is required for all subdivisions containing mapped wetlands as determined from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service national wetland inventory maps.
- 11. Per BCRC 12-732 (A), A wetland delineation is required for all subdivisions containing a wetland based on a wetlands reconnaissance as required in section 12-731. Exception: Subdivisions where all building sites are delineated on the plat are outside of a wetland based on the wetlands reconnaissance.

12. Per BCRC 12-651 (G), the preliminary short plat shall be valid for a period not to exceed two (2) calendar years from the date of approval. At any time prior to the expiration date of the preliminary short plat, an applicant may make a written request to the planning director for an extension of the preliminary short plat for a period up to two (2) years, finding that conditions or applicable regulations have not changed so substantially as to warrant reconsideration of the proposed subdivision with respect to the public health, safety, and general welfare. The planning director may recommend such request for extension at any regular business meeting of the board of commissioners. The extension request must be approved or denied prior to the expiration date of the preliminary short plat.

NOTE: Any determination made by the Planning Director or his designee in the administration of this decision may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners by notifying the Planning Director in writing of the intent to appeal within ten (10) calendar days from the date of this determination. (BCRC 12-653(h)).



RESOLUTION 25 -

BONNER COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY IN BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO

Flooding December 11, 2025

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 46-1011 - LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCIES states as follows:

- (1) A local disaster emergency may be declared only by a mayor or chairman of the county commissioners within their respective political subdivisions. It shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven (7) days except by or with the consent of the governing board of the political subdivision. Any order or proclamation declaring, continuing, or terminating a local disaster emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the local county recorder.
- (2) The effect of the declaration of a local disaster emergency is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local or intergovernmental disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance thereunder.
- (3) No intergovernmental agency or official thereof may declare a local disaster emergency, unless expressly authorized by the agreement pursuant to which the agency functions. However, an intergovernmental disaster agency shall provide aid and services in accordance with the agreement pursuant to which it functions.

WHEREAS, there is a threat to life and property in Bonner County due to snow melt, warming temperatures and rain resulting in flooding; and

WHEREAS, flooding has the potential to cause mudslides and damage to roads and levees; and

WHEREAS, rising lakes, rivers and streams have the potential to endanger life, property, and structures; and

WHEREAS, planning and mitigation efforts may result in the immediate work effort to minimize the threat; and

WHEREAS, Bonner County Chairman Brian Domke made a verbal declaration on Thursday, December 11, 2025 at 4:06 a.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Bonner County Board of Commissioners, by virtue of the authority vested in Section 46-1011 of the Idaho Code, do hereby find and declare a local disaster emergency exists in Bonner County, Idaho. This declaration is due to threat to life and property in Bonner County as the result of snow melt, warming temperatures and rain resulting in flooding in Bonner County.

ADOPTED as a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho upon a majority vote on the 16th day of December, 2025.

COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

and

Bonner County, Idaho for

EMERGENCY FLOOD RESPONSE ASSISTANCE

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 11th day of December 2025, by and between THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (hereinafter referred to as the "Government") acting by and through the District Engineer, Seattle District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and Bonner County, (hereinafter referred to as the "Public Sponsor"), acting by and through Mr. Brian Domke.

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, 33 USC 701n authorizes the Chief of Engineers to flood fight and perform rescue operations.

WHEREAS, the Public Sponsor has requested assistance under 33 USC 701n, and the Public Sponsor qualifies for such assistance in accordance with the established policies of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

WHEREAS, the Public Sponsor hereby represents that it has the authority and legal capability to furnish the non-Federal cooperation hereinafter set forth and is willing to participate with the terms of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will perform flood fight activities in support of the Public Sponsor's efforts.
- 2. The Public Sponsor will:
- a. Provide without cost to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers all lands, easements, and rights-of-ways, relocations, and borrow and dredged or excavated material disposal areas necessary for the work.
- b. Hold and save the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers free from damages arising from construction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, and rehabilitation of the work, except damages due to the fault or negligence of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or its contractors.
- c. Operate, maintain, repair, replace, and rehabilitate the completed work in a manner satisfactory to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
- d. Remove or make permanent, at no cost to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, all temporary work constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
 - 3. Description of Work:

Supplement Bonner County's efforts to stabilize the riverbank along multiple locations on the East Spring, Lighting, Trestle, and Johnson Creeks. The Corps will mitigate scour concerns along the riverbank to ensure Spring Creek, E. Spring Creek, and Lightning Creek Roads can remain accessible for emergency responders and allow for evacuations. These measures are temporary and intended to provide a flood protection until the damaged levee is repaired.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this agreement of the day and year first above written.

Re: University of Idaho, Extension – County Extension Budget Agreement Updated

This is an updated version of the University of Idaho, Extension—County Extension Budget Agreement that was brought before the BOCC at a previous meeting. In the previous version, the total budget amount in appendix A did not match the budget amount listed in section 3.

As previously mentioned, University of Idaho Extension, the counties in Idaho and the United States federal government have had a cooperative arrangement in providing research-based information to the residents in the counties of Idaho. To formalize the cooperative agreement, University of Idaho Extension submits the proposed agreement. The intent of this agreement is to provide a clear understanding and written documentation for both the university and Bonner County as to the relationship that exists between both parties. Part of this agreement includes the County Extension Budget form (Appendix A).

Cooperative Agreement for University of Idaho Extension Programs

This cooperative agreement is effective the date of last signature and is between Bonner County ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, and the Regents of the University of Idaho, a public university of the state of Idaho ("University") to promote and provide cooperative extension programs ("Extension Programs") as mandated by federal and state law.

University and County enter into this Cooperation Agreement to set out the nature of the Extension Program and the relationship of the parties.

University is the land-grant university in the state of Idaho, as authorized by the federal Morrill Acts of 1862 (7 U.S.C. §§301-308 and U.S.C. §§321-329), and the state of Idaho approved that Act, specifically:

The assent of the legislature of the state of Idaho is hereby given to all the provisions of an act of Congress, approved July 2, 1862, entitled, "An act donating public lands to the several states which may provide colleges for the benefit of agriculture and the mechanic arts," and the acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto. (I.C. § 33-2901)

The federal Smith-Lever Act of 1914 (7 U.S.C. §§341-349) established Extension Services, a collaboration of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the land-grant universities, and the state of Idaho approved that Act, specifically:

The state board of education and board of regents of the University of Idaho are authorized and empowered to receive the grants of money appropriated under such act, and to organize and conduct agricultural extension work which shall be carried on in connection with the terms and conditions expressed in the act of Congress aforesaid; and the treasurer of the state board of education and board of regents of the University of Idaho is hereby designated as the officer to whom all moneys granted to the state of Idaho under said act shall be paid. (I.C. § 33-2904)

The Idaho Legislature has established an extension service and has enabled Idaho's various counties to become a cooperative collaborator in promoting Extension Services, specifically:

The board of county commissioners of the several counties within the state of Idaho are hereby authorized and empowered to provide funds for demonstration work in agriculture and home economics within said counties and for the employment of extension agents in agriculture and home economics in cooperation with the University of Idaho and the United States department of agriculture; and board of regents of the University of Idaho to receive the grants of money appropriated under said act and to organize and conduct agricultural extension work which shall be carried on in connection with the college of agriculture of the state university in accordance with the terms and conditions expressed in the said act of Congress. (IC §31-839)

Extension programs are developed in response to local needs, based on advice from a County Extension Advisory Committee, County Commissioners, and other appropriate partners.

University and County therefore agree as follows:

1. Term and Renewal.

This agreement shall govern Extension Programs during fiscal year 2026 beginning [October 1, 2025] and ending at 11:59pm on [September 30, 2026] ("Term").

2. Extension Programs.

University shall provide and administer Extension Programs within County. Extension Programs are directed at improving the quality of life for people in County, enhancing economic opportunity within County, and sustaining the natural resources of County. Educational activities, field days, local leadership development, training schools, etc., are part of Extension Programs are acceptable expenses for reimbursement from the operating budget provided by County (see Appendix A).

3. Operating Budget.

- a. County shall provide a total of \$165,863.00 for Extension Programs in its annual County budget for the Term of this agreement ("Contract Cost Limitation"). A summary of the budget items and anticipated expenditures are stated in **Appendix A**. University shall not exceed the Contract Cost Limitation without obtaining prior written consent from County.
 - County may subdivide the budgeted items listed in the summary to conform to County's system of account titles. County shall authorize each account, handled by University faculty, employees and County staff.
 - ii. County shall have the right to annually audit any authorized accounts by itself or by a County-authorized auditor. All Extension Personnel shall follow all county policies and procedures for financial expenditures. "Extension Personnel" is defined as any UI & County faculty and staff hired to carry out Extension Programs.
 - iii. Reimbursement or purchasing requests for budgeted expenditures shall be submitted to County in accordance with County procedures.
 - iv. Extension employees shall keep accurate and detailed records of expenses incurred in accordance with County fiscal procedures.

4. Extension Office Faculty.

- a. Subject to policies, procedures, availability of funding, University shall provide and fund one or more University Extension Faculty assigned to perform Extension Programs within County, including, but not limited to the following positions: Extension Educator. University shall appoint one University employee to act as the Extension County Chair for County ("Extension County Chair").
- b. Additional employees may be funded by University, County, or a combination of University and County, as may be mutually agreed and set forth below and subject to University funding, policies, and procedures. All University employees shall be governed by University policies and procedures. All County employees shall be governed by County policies and procedures.

5. Extension Office Support Staff.

a. County shall recruit, hire and evaluate support staff (e.g. secretary, program assistant, volunteer leaders, office manager, office specialist, etc.) according to County personnel policies and procedures, in cooperation with the Extension County Chair ("County Extension Staff"). County Support Staff shall be (i) County employees whose recruitment, hiring, evaluation, and employment is governed by County rules and regulations and other administrative County policies, and (ii) supervised by Extension County Chair in cooperation with County Human Resources.

6. Facilities and Equipment.

- a. County shall provide facilities and equipment for use by University and county employees, as set forth in Appendix B (include in Appendix B a brief description and address of each provided facility, i.e. County Extension Office, address, office maintenance, equipment, supplies, and other operating expenses).
- b. If this agreement is terminated, all equipment purchased or furnished by County or University for the benefit of County Extension Office, shall be returned to original purchaser/supplier.

7. Coordination.

- a. The Extension County Chair, with the advice and consent of the University Extension District Directors and University Director of Extension, shall directly coordinate all Extension Programs, the operating budget, and the support staff, as allowed under the provisions of this agreement, within County in order to:
 - Help the residents of County analyze their problems, develop solutions, and thereby attain a richer and more satisfying life. Extension Programs shall be designed to render effective educational service and to stay within the total dollar amount of the above-recited operating budget;
 - ii. Manage the operating budget in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

Vehicle Use.

- a. Where applicable, Extension Faculty or Extension Staff may use their own vehicle, if it is registered and insured as required in County and/or by state law. County shall reimburse Extension employees for reasonable mileage driven to conduct and deliver the Extension Programs described in this agreement according to with County's approved mileage rate and policy for those miles. Reimbursement for mileage shall not exceed that amount budgeted in Appendix A.
- No Discrimination. University and County shall provide Extension Programs to all segments of the County's population without discrimination based on race, color, sex, sexual orientation, sexual identity, age, disability, religion, or national origin.
- 10. **Equal Opportunity**. County and University shall comply with all applicable county, state, and federal laws and regulations concerning Equal Employment Opportunity.

11. Liability.

- restrictions concerning the acceptance of liability, including the Idaho Tort Claims Act. It is the intention of the Parties that each will be responsible for its own negligent acts and omissions and those of its employees, officers, agents, and contractors. If the County is providing a County owned vehicle for University's use under this agreement, the Parties understand that the Idaho Tort Claims Act, Idaho Code § 6-903(2)(ii), states that each party's liability is secondary to the obligation of an insurer or indemnitor of any automobile or other vehicle not owned or leased by the Party.
- County shall promptly notify the University of Idaho Risk Manager at <u>risk@uidaho.edu</u>, or 208-885-6177, of any claim it has knowledge of and shall cooperate fully with the University or its representatives in the defense of the same;

- a. The University shall promptly notify Bonner County Risk Management, 1500 Highway2, Suite 337, Sandpoint, ID 83864, 208-265-7974, riskmanagement@bonnercountyid.gov of any claim it has knowledge of and shall cooperate fully with the County or its representatives in the defense of the same.
- 12. **Signatory Authority**. No person who is not an authorized signatory may enter into binding contract negotiations, or approve or execute a contract on behalf of University without explicit written permission from an authorized signatory. Those signing without such authority may incur personal liability, and/or may be subject to discipline by University, including termination.
- 13. **Severability**. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this Agreement.
- 14. Assignment. This Agreement shall not be assigned by either party.
- 15. Jurisdiction. This agreement shall be governed and interpreted by the laws of the State of Idaho.


