Updates on Planning Department Activities

- Monthly Planning Related Meetings
 - o Discussed upcoming calendar, no meetings next week
- Monthly Application Reports
 - Title 11 busy time of year
 - o Title 12 moratorium
 - o Public Record Requests on par with the time of year
- Department Updates
 - Software EnerGov: working on implementation, going live June 1; Self-Service: making sure only allowing public information, making as much public facing as they can, live first with BLPs and Vacation Rental Permits
 - o Staffing hearing coordinator position open, doing interviews
 - o Financial increased revenues, slight increase in expenses (P&Z meals, mileage)
