Meeting:

Meeting called to order at around 12:09 PM

Agenda

LPSCC reviewed the agenda of the meeting, Tyacke moved to approve the agenda and Aanensen seconded the motion to approve. The agenda was unanimously approved.

March 7, 2025 Minutes. Jacobson moved to approve the agenda and Chilton seconded the motion to approve. The minutes were unanimously approved.

March 14, 2025 Minutes. Jacobson moved to approve the agenda and Magruder seconded the motion to approve. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Public Comment

Public Comment was opened and there was no Public Comment:

Columbia County's application for Justice Reinvestment Program and request for support from LPSCC.

Evenson did a presentation of the proposal. There were two different items that needed LPSCC approval. LPSCC needs to approve JRI to make an adjustment request within the JRI formula grant. They were looking to move \$9,000.00 from their training and travel category, continuing education line item, to their personnel category, Intervention specialist line item. This is needed to cover the extra cost of the intervention specialist. JRI also is looking to move \$9,350.00 from their Housing and facilities category, prorated rent line item to our supplies category, treatment and transitional supplies line item.

The second item JRI needed LPSCC approval to apply for the JRI grant for the 25-27 biennium and approval to opt in for the competitive grant which pays for their DDA and PPO positions within our JRI program.

Tyacke moved to approve the budget transfers as discussed above and Magruder seconded the motion to approve. The budget transfers were unanimously approved.

Clarke moved to approve LPSCC approval of Community Corrections application for the JRI grant for the 25-27 biennium and approval to opt in for the competitive grant which pays for their DDA and PPO positions within our JRI program and Magruder seconded the motion to approve. The budget transfers were unanimously approved. Lang will prepare a letter of LPSCC for the grant application.

Update on the Jail Levy Measure: Macfarlane indicated that levy is on the ballot for May. He also indicated that the current levy expires June 30, 2025. If the levy fails in May, the jail only has some additional funding for a couple months after June 30 before the jail would be forced to reduce capacity.

New Business: Kercher discussed Amani Center’s new space and development of Mental Health Services. There is a ribbon cutting ceremony on April 23, 2025 at noon.

Adjournment. Jacobson moved to adjourn the meeting. Magruder seconded the motion. Lang called the question and vote to adjourn was unanimous. Meeting ended around 12:24 PM
