**Columbia County Department of Community Justice 2025-2027 Biennial plan.** Evenson presented the biennial plan for Columbia County’s Department of Justice. The plan has been provided to the members. Evenson indicated that the funding was stagnant and there were no increases. LPSCC needed to review the plan and provide a letter of support for the plan. Letter would be provided by the chair. Clarke moved to approve the biennial plan and Chilton seconded the motion and having Lang write LPSCC’s letter of support for the plan for . Lang called for the question and the plan was approved and Lang indicated that he would write the letter.

**Community Needs Assessments - CCMH:** Jacobson asked LPSCC if there was any further feedback by LPSCC members about the community needs assessment. Jacobson indicated that Pathways residential treatment will be moving to the CCMH campus in a new building. There are plans to have detox services available with the new treatment facility. He also indicated that the current Pathways treatment building will transition to transitional housing. Chilton requested that CCMH focus on providing more services to the rural areas. Also, discussed that CCMH be connected more with the schools. Jacobson discussed that CCMH will be looking to bring in a mental health crises stabilization facility for the area.
