Meeting Minutes

Call Meeting to Order

Claire Catt called the meeting to Order at 1:16 p.m.

Approve Agenda

Scott Jorgensen moved to approve the agenda as presented. Tammy Maygra seconded. All were in favor, and the motion passed.

3. Annual Report Presentation to County Commissioners on April 30, 2025.

- Claire Catt and Scott Jorgensen will attend the April 30, 2025, Board of County Commissioners meeting to present the Annual JOCAC Report. Claire invited all members to attend.

Other Business

- Tammy Maygra had questions about how much a Marshal Hold pays per day and whether increasing the number of Marshal Hold beds would make the jail self-sufficient. Sarah Hanson, County Counsel, shared that the County Commissioners adopted a jail matrix a couple of months ago that does increase the number of Marshal Holds and reduces the number of local beds. After the discussion, the committee asked if Sarah would please share the jail matrix and asked if Captain Macfarlane could provide budgetary numbers.
- Scott Jorgensen thanked Captain Macfarlane for providing the number of inmates in 2024. There were 2,108 total inmate bookings into the jail, 1648 (78.2%) male and 460 (21.0%) female.
- Scott would really like to share these numbers with the communities. These people have done something bad or are bad people. Do we want them roaming the streets? It would also be nice to see what charges were connected to these bookings.
