Public Comment

Public Comment was opened and there was no Public Comment:

GOBHI Presentation on Sequential Intercept Mapping: Medford and Clifford did a presentation of a service GOBHI offers to communities to do Sequential Intercept Mapping. This is to examine the priorities of the community to address needs and priorities of how the public/individuals intercept within the social services, justice system, law enforcement and public safety. The intercepts are broken down into a 0 – 5 range. 0 is the Community intercept, 1 is Law Enforcement, 2 is Initial Detention, 3 is Jails/Courts, 4 Re-Entry from prison and 5 is Community corrections/Community Supports. The last time this was done in Columbia County was 2019. The mapping projects were interrupted with the pandemic.

Pixley motioned to approve LPSCC supporting doing the Sequential Intercept Mapping and having Jacobson and CCMH coordinate with GOBHI to schedule it. Cole Seconded. Motion was approved unanimously.

Update on the Jail Levy Measure: Pixley reported that the measure passed.
