

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
DAILY MEETING
April 27, 2020
MINUTES

Present: Commissioner Alex Tardif, Commissioner Margaret Magruder, Commissioner Henry Heimuller, Sarah Hanson, County Counsel and Jacyn Normine, Board Office Administrator via telecommunication with county staff and members of the public.

Public Health Update:

Mike Paul, Public Health Director gave an update on COVID-19. Oregon has 2,311 confirmed cases, 46,653 negative test results, 91 deaths. A total of 546 individuals have been hospitalized while infected. Columbia County is still holding at 14 confirmed cases, 603 negative test results.

Mike Paul will be attending multiple meetings this week to discuss base line of infection contact investigations and frame work for reopening.

PPE has been delivered to Columbia County that included 30 test kits and hand sanitizer. If you need hand sanitizer fill out the form and submit to Shaun Brown.

Other Business:

Kathleen Boutin-Pasterz updated the Board on the Clean Harbors Contract for Household Hazardous Waste Collections events to include a 6% increase for 2020. After discussion the Board directed staff to place the contract with Clean Harbors on a consent agenda for approval.

Commissioner Discussion

Commissioner Magruder thanked Cascade Tissues again for their donation and noted that if you need toilet paper to please call the Boards office at 503-397-4322. Commissioner Heimuller noted that approx. 85% of the 300 cases (26,000 rolls) has been distributed throughout the county.

Department Head & Staff Discussion:

Jean Ripa, HR Director presented a cleaning list to the Board for discussion. COVID-19 enhanced sanitation wipe downs were ordered by the Board to take place every two hours. Sanitation wipe downs were taking place every two hours while the Courthouse was open to the public. Now, that the Courthouse is closed to the public the every two hour sanitation has been reduced to about twice a day. Jean Ripa and Maintenance asked the Board for direction on wipe down sanitations and how often these need to take place. Discussion was held on what housekeeping does on a daily and weekly basis. Staff will present an amended temporary policy to the Board to modify the language on how often wipe downs and cleaning will need to take place for approval.

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Executive Session:

The Board recessed for regular session to enter into Executive Session under 192.660(2)(d) upon coming out of executive session no action was taken.

With nothing further coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
