
A public hearing was held beginning at 7:00 P.M. to review an application to change the land use classification from Agriculture to Agriculture with a Special Permit to operate a limestone quarry in the NE1/4NW1/4 of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 68 West and lies West of I-25 near Glendo. Applicant Jay Collins was present to answer any questions concerning the application. There were no people in attendance to speak in opposition of the application.

A motion was made by Bill Klein to recommend a "do pass" to the Board of County Commissioners to approve the application to change the land use classification from Agriculture to Agriculture with a Special Permit to operate a gravel quarry. Marty Shepard seconded the motion and it passed with Jay Collins abstaining from the vote.

The balance of the meeting was spent in a workshop on the rules and regulations changes.

The next meeting will be held on May 14, 2001 at 7:00 P.M. The Planning Board would like the Commissioners to be able to sit in on this workshop.
