

**A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

DECLARING AUGUST 2nd AS
NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2016**

- WHEREAS:** The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique, nationwide “lights on” campaign and celebration against crime, drug and violence on August 2, 2016 entitled, “National Night Out”; and
- WHEREAS:** The “33rd Annual National Night Out” provides an opportunity for the City of Placerville to join forces with 37.8 million people and 16,124 communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases in promoting cooperative, police-community crime prevention efforts; and
- WHEREAS:** The City Council plays a vital role in assisting the Placerville Police Department through joint crime, drug and violence prevention efforts in the City of Placerville and is supporting “National Night Out 2016” locally; and
