Subject: Adopt a resolution approving the purchase of a new P342 400', 120M sewer video system in the amount of \$12,987.00 from Advanced Infrastructure Technologies.

Discussion: A Sewer Video Inspection System is an essential tool for Public Works Departments. The system allows employees to perform and record pipeline inspections as mandated within the City's Sewer System Management Plan. The City's existing video system is in need of constant repair and cannot record long expanses between manholes.

Analysis: Given the current condition of the City's Video Inspection System and its inability to record over long expanses it has been determined that it is in the City's best interest to replace the existing system with a new Advanced Infrastructure Technologies Video System. The system comes equipped with a 2" camera, 2" sonde, P350 battery, onboard controller, radio detection RD7000DL and locator receiver.

Cost: The City received the following camera system bids: Advanced Infrastructure Technologies, LLC (\$12,025.00), Pearpoint (\$13,291.80) and 3T Equipment Company Inc. (\$16,409.88). Advanced Infrastructure Technologies was the lowest responsive bidder that was able to meet bid specifications for the system and is therefore recommended for purchase.

Budget Impact: The City Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2015/2016 Operating Budget which assumed \$13,000 for the purchase of a Video Inspection System. The purchase price of \$12,987.00 is within the \$13,000 budget.

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution approving the purchase of a new P342 400', 120M sewer video system in the amount of \$12,987.00 from Advanced Infrastructure Technologies.
