Construction date: circa 1851

This house was reportedly built by John Blair in 1851. James Madison Anderson, one time Sheriff of El Dorado County moved his family into this residence in 1898. Gertrude Thompson, nee Anderson, daughter of James Madison Anderson, inherited the house open the death of her parents. Mr. and Mrs. Thompson extensively remodeled the interior of the home, however, the outside retained its integrity. Presently, the building houses the law offices of Daryl McKinstry. It seems fitting and proper for this house to be used for law offices again. James Madison Anderson, one time sheriff of El Dorado County, followed by the late George H. Thompson, attorney, and later Judge; and now, Daryl McKinstry, attorney-at-law.
