They are very exciting to be working with Ventnor this year and they would like to come back and meet with the Commissioners as the event gets closer to address any concerns and answer any questions that the public and Commissioners may have. WHEREAS, **Good Time Tricycle, LLC d/b/a Downbeach Seafood Festival** has requested and the City desires to grant a license to the **Good Time Tricycle, LLC d/b/a Downbeach Seafood Festival** to use Ski Beach to produce a Seafood Festival on Saturday, September 7, 2019 with a rain date of Sunday, September 8, 2019 (“Festival”); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Festival will have a positive economic impact for the City; and

WEREAS, the License Agreement also requires insurance and indemnification to protect the City’s interest against claims related to the use of Ski Beach for the Festival;

WHEREAS, in order to insure the safety of the event staff and volunteers as well as the general public, certain closures and no parking enforcement are necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Ventnor City, County of Atlantic, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest to (1) a License agreement with **Good Time Tricycle, LLC d/b/a Downbeach Seafood Festival** in substantially the form attached for the use of Ski Beach to hold the Festival as

described in the agreement; and (2) any ancillary agreement that may be required by the State of New Jersey for the issuance of an alcoholic beverage concessionaire license including a Concessionaire’s Agreement in the form required by the State;

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Ventnor City, New Jersey find that the amending certain aspects of existing ordinances is an important matter; and

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VENTNOR, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 214 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC PART 2 PARKING METERS OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VENTNOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Ventnor City as follows:

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Ventnor City, New Jersey find that the amending certain aspects of existing ordinances is an important matter; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 214 Vehicles and Traffic Part 2 Parking Meters be amended in its entirety as set forth below.

THEREFORE, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Ventnor City, New Jersey do ordain as follows.

**Article XIV
Meter Fees**

[Added 5-11-2017 by Ord. No. 2017-13]

§ 214-62 **Parking meter charge.**
Per hour, not to exceed: \$2.

The use of Parksmarter mobile App shall be a minimum charge of one-hour in addition to a \$0.35 convenience fee that is inclusive of all transaction fees to the company.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION III. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, sentence or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, the City Commissioners wish to extend the Weekend Open Cooking on the Beach in addition to the Holiday weekends of Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day on the Beach; and

WHEREAS, all weekends beginning June 1 through September 30, Saturday and Sunday will be permitted without a permit; and

WHEREAS, in addition, cooking on the beach is allowed for the following holidays without any permits; and

WHEREAS, 4th of July: Thursday July 4th 2019, Friday, July 5th 2019, Saturday July 6th 2019 and Sunday July 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Labor Day: Saturday August 31, 2019, and Sunday September 1, 2019 and Monday September 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Cooking on the Beach hours shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, any person taking advantage of such privileges must follow all ordinances of the City of Ventnor and all State and Federal laws. Cooking will be permitted provided that all fires are contained in a commercial type propane grill (no propane tanks bigger than 20 lbs) and are tended to during the cooking of food. All individuals are responsible for the removal of any such equipment and any and all trash which is generated as a result of said cooking. **Open fires such as bon-fires or charcoal grills are strictly prohibited on the beach.**

WHEREAS, pop up 10x0 tents are allowable, no tent should be enclosed by order of the Fire Department.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Commissioners authorize Weekend Cooking from June 1st through September 30th in addition to the Holiday weekends of Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day on the Beach.
