

The Ventnor City Board of Recreation held its meeting on Tuesday, August 13, 2019 at 6:30pm at our recreational complex in accordance with the sunshine law.

Present: Diane Birkbeck, Paul Hydro, Mike Cahill, Joe Calvi, Joe Iannuzzelli, Klaudia Advena (6:35pm).

Motion was made to approve July 2019 minutes by Paul Hydro and seconded by Joe Calvi, Jr. All were in favor.

Jack Feinberg was present on behalf of Pickleball. At last month's meeting a representative was there, Patty and the board discussed some concerns of them having lessons, etc., at this meeting the board discussed and agreed with Patty to some basic language and rules. These were placed and writing and Jack Feinberg attended that he agreed to them on behalf of the Pickleball group.

His only concern was the instructors having to have liability insurance. He stated that there are only 2 organizations where you can buy a policy, PPR and IPTPA. He will discuss that with Mr. Thomas when he returns to work. Also was stated that this needs to go to the Governing Body for the final approval and if approved would go into effect for next year.

He asked that when they have their free clinics (that is for beginners and intermediate members) in the evenings that they possibly use more than 1 court as stated in the instructor's paperwork.

A suggestion was made since so popular, possibly in the future utilize the basketball courts early in the am. 8-11am possibly. Put down a different color line for pickleball courts and the use a portable net. And the overflow courts would not be set up UNLESS there are reservations that warrant the extra courts being set up, otherwise it is a basketball court.

**Board member Calvi suggested after Mr. Feinberg left the meeting that the overflow courts if needed only from 8-10am, not 11am like Mr. Feinberg suggested. So this would have to be agreed upon if board moves in that direction

There was a temporary approval made tonight meeting by the rec board, motion by Klaudia Advena and seconded by Joe Iannuzzelli. Mr. Thomas has to discuss Mr. Feinberg's concern
