Tennis- This year made the most profit ever, \$16,700 this year. Even with 2 less tennis courts, tennis did very well. Pickleball came in higher this year. Combined profits nearly \$30,000. Profits were at \$8,500 in 2016.

Volleyball the program did very well. It did have some complaints about not social distancing etc. The Volleyball director did a great job keeping all COVID requirements present at each game. Unfortunately, due to outside program you couldn't always be on top of everyone with the restrictions but overall did a good job.

Girls softball did very well, no complaints or as far as we know, no one got sick.
