

OCEAN CITY INAUGURATION & REORGANIZATION MINUTES
MONDAY, JULY 1, 2024 – 12:00 P.M.
OCEAN CITY MUSIC PIER

ATTENDANCE: Mr. Barnes, Mr. Crowley, Mr. Hartzell, Mr. Levchuk, Mr. Madden, Mr. Polcini, and Mr. Winslow. Present also was Mayor Gillian, Business Administrator, Mr. Savastano, and Solicitor, Ms. McCrosson.

City Clerk, Ms. Rasner called the meeting to order and announced that adequate notice of this meeting has been given pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231.

NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF PRESIDENT OF CITY COUNCIL:

The city clerk announced that nominations are now open for the office of council president for a one year term beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025. All nominations will be voted on in the order they are received. Mr. Winslow made a motion to nominate Mr. Madden as Council President, seconded by Mr. Crowley. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF VICE PRESIDENT OF CITY COUNCIL:

The city clerk announced that nominations are now open for the office of council vice president for a one year term beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025. Again all nominations will be voted on in the order in which they are received. Mr. Madden made a motion to nominate Mr. Crowley as Vice President, seconded by Mr. Winslow. Under a roll call vote there were all ayes.

The City clerk turned the meeting over to Council President, Mr. Madden.
