As required by statute, we have to have a public workshop session to go over the progress in preparing the 2023 budget; and that's what we're doing this morning.

I want to share with you that we've been able to summarize the submissions from all five departments and have -- as we look at that, we have not been able to do much analysis on it because of the timing of the submissions, but we do have some time to take a hard look at that.

I want to emphasize two things: the submission that we have right now does not meet the appropriation cap requirement, nor does it meet the levy cap requirement. And I think I would view this budget submission so far as being a very preliminary rough draft that we need to continue to work on before we have a public introduction of the budget on April 4th.

John Ditinyak is here. He has been working on the numbers, and continues to work on them. So what I expect is that we'll need to take a hard look at our submissions and provide John with revised numbers as soon as possible to, you know, refine the draft that we have.

You each have your own packets. You each have details of what you submitted, and John can help you go through the areas that we think might be areas that need to be focused in on. John, do you have any further comments? MR. DITINYAK: Can you hear me? Thank you, Commissioner, Mayor, other Commissioners. My office is here to help and provide support for the 2023 budget submissions. As Commissioner Evans said, we're going to look at some of the major areas of the budget and help out and refine some of the submissions that we've received. If we're going to introduce by the 4th, I really would like to get, sort of, final numbers locked down a week from today, so March 29th. that's really the deadline we should be working for. MAYOR SCARPELLI: All right. Well, let's all go to work. Let's sharpen our pencils. Let's see where we can get in a week, and so we're ready introduction on the 4th.

COMMISSIONER EVANS: Agreed. Any other comments, because that's -- basically, you have your packets. You're looking at them for the first time. And it's just time to get down to the details.

COMMISSIONER TUCCI: John, I just took a

quick look at my packet. And I think you've captured 1 everything correctly. Obviously, as you're aware, the 2 major increases in my department are health benefits 3 and insurance. Okay. So that's something beyond our 4 5 Everything else in the Parks and Public Property Department is flat. So we've come out with, 6 7 for the first time in maybe 23 years, Commissioner, 8 exactly the same numbers. So, thank you. 9 COMMISSIONER EVANS: Actually, that's a milestone. 10 11 MAYOR SCARPELLI: Any other comments, Commissioners? 12 13 COMMISSIONER KELLY: I would just like to thank my staff, especially Sharon Lemma-Bozza and 14 15 Meredith Blank, on working on this budget for the 16 Public Affairs and Health Department. It looks like we are actually down 1.24 percent, so that's a round 17 18 of applause for them. So, thank you to everyone in my 19 department. 20 All right. MAYOR SCARPELLI: Let's go to 21 We'll reconvene on the 4th, and everybody get 22 together with Mr. Ditinyak. And I'm sure 23 Mr. Sarinelli is available in case anybody needs to 24 talk to him. Correct? 25 MR. SARINELLI: Yes.
