WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-14 requires municipalities to adopt a cash management plan to deposit, or invest, or both deposit and invest its funds under this plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the cash management plan is to ensure the investment of local funds is in interest-bearing accounts and other permitted investments; and

WHEREAS, the cash management plan shall set policies for selecting and evaluating investment instruments accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the cash management plan shall be approved annually by a majority vote of the governing body and may be modified from time to time to reflect changes in Federal or State law or regulations or the designation of depositories, funds, or investment instruments or the authorization for investments; and

WHEREAS, the cash management plan shall be subject to the annual audit conducted pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:5-4; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer shall be charged with administering the cash management plan; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer charged with the custody of money shall deposit or invest them as designated or authorized by the cash management plan and shall, after that, be relieved of any liability for loss of such sums of money due to the insolvency or closing of any depository designated by, or the decrease in value of any investment authorized by the cash management plan; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted for the Board of Commissioners' approval a proposed cash management plan; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board Commissioners of Nutley Township, that:

- 1. The cash management plan proposed by the Chief Financial Officer with the approval of the Board Commissioners is adopted as the cash management plan of the Township of Nutley; and
- 2. All Township of Nutley officers with custody of public funds are directed, pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:5-14, to deposit and invest those funds under the adopted cash management plan.

CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. Cash Management and Investment Objectives

The Township of Nutley's objectives are:

- A. Preservation of capital.
- B. Adequate safekeeping of assets.

- C. Maintenance of liquidity to meet operating needs.
- D. Investment of assets per State and Federal Laws and regulations.
- E. Maximize yield with minimum risk.

2. Designation of Official Depositories

The following Government Unit Protection Act approved banks are authorized depositories for the deposit of funds:

Capital One Bank
Citizens Bank
New Jersey Cash Management Fund
TD Bank
US Bank
Valley National Bank

Designated official depositories must submit to the Chief Financial Officer a copy of the Governmental Unit Deposit Protection Act Notification of eligibility, filed semiannually with the Department of Banking each June 30th and December 31st of each year.

3. Designation of Authorized Signers

All warrants or checks for the disbursement of money shall be made by any three (3) of the following official and facsimile signatures may be used:

Township Mayor Township Clerk Director of Revenue & Finance Deputy Municipal Clerk

Chief Financial Officer

4. Cash Management

- A. All funds shall be deposited within 48 hours of receipt per N.J.S.A. 40A 5-15.
- B. The Chief Financial Officer shall minimize the possibility of idle cash accumulating in accounts by assuring that any excess amounts not needed to cover expenses or more than negotiated compensating balances are kept in interest-bearing accounts or promptly swept into the investment portfolio.
- C. Investment decisions shall be guided by the cash flow projections prepared by the Chief Financial Officer.
- D. Facsimile signatures for two of the three authorized signers are approved for all checks issued by the Township. Each check must bear at least one manual signature.

5. Permissible Investments

- A. Interest-bearing bank accounts are authorized for depositing local unit funds (GUDPA approved) and Certificates of Deposit.
- B. Government money market mutual funds comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15(e).
- C. Bonds or other obligations of the local unit or school district of which the local unit is a part.
- D. New Jersey Cash Management Fund.
- E. Local government investment pools like New Jersey Class and the New Jersey Arbitrage Rebate Management Program.

6. Authority for Investment Management

The Chief Financial Officer is granted responsibility and authority to manage this Cash Management Plan and Policy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14. No person may engage in an investment transaction except as provided under the terms of this policy and the written procedures established by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to make investments on behalf of the Township. All investment decisions shall be consistent with this plan and all appropriate regulatory constraints.

7. Reporting

The Chief Financial Officer shall report investments to the Board of Commissioners per N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-14.

8. Audit

The Cash Management Plan shall be subject to an annual audit conducted according to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-14.

9. <u>Disposition of Abandoned Property</u>

The Chief Financial Officer shall escheat (revert property to the state in the absence of claimants) to the State of New Jersey checks that remain outstanding for more than twelve months after the date of issuance.
