Whereas, Jeanne has been a driving force in bringing the enriching programs to the Nutley community, including adult lectures, concerts, and craft workshops, and has thoughtfully curated the Library's Adult Fiction and Media collections to serve readers of all interests:

Whereas, Jeanne played an integral role in planning and executing the Nutley Public Library's Centennial Celebration in 2014, helping to honor and showcase the library's rich history and its lasting impact on the community;

Whereas, Jeanne is a passionate advocate for literacy and lifelong learning, a valued member of several BCCLS committees, and a true believer in the mission of public libraries to educate, inspire, and connect with their communities;

Whereas, she has demonstrated extraordinary commitment to the Friends of the Library, generously donating proceeds from her handcrafted jewelry and crafts to support Nutley -- support library initiatives and dedicating personal time to volunteer causes;

9	tax charges in the amount of \$4,559.22 for Blocks 7805,
10	Lot 22, and Block 101, Lot 15.

1 DEPUTY MAYOR EVANS: Okay. The next resolutions are -- all of them are being read on behalf 2 of the entire Board, the first one, 88 -- 188-25. 3 It's a resolution designating PB Nutclif 4 5 Master, LLC as redeveloper of the redevelopment area covered by the Roche Southside Kingsland Street 6 7 Redevelopment Plan. Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the 8 9 Township of Nutley identified certain properties in the Township designated as follows on the Tax Map of the 10 Township: Blocks 2000, Lots 1, 4, and 5; Block 2101, 11 Lot 1, to be considered for designation as a 12 condemnation area in need of redevelopment, pursuant to 13 the Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1; 14 15 Whereas, on March 18th, pursuant the Resolution 64 -- 67-14, the Board of Commissioners 16 requested the Township Planning Board to conduct a 17 18 preliminary investigation to determine if a study area 19 satisfied the carry -- criteria for designation as a 20 condemned area -- condemnation area in need of 21 redevelopment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; 22 Whereas, Maser Consulting prepared an 23 investigation of the study area for the Township dated 24 February 5th, 2014;

On March 3rd, 2015, the Board of

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Commissioners determined that the redevelopment area 1 constitutes and meets the criteria under the LRHL to be 2 designated as a condemnation area in need of a 3 redevelopment, that the Redevelopment Area should be 4 determined and declared a condemnation "area in 5 redevelopment", and which determination, among other 6 7 things, authorizes the Township to exercise the power 8 of eminent domain to acquire all or a portion of such 9 Redevelopment Area; Whereas, the Township and PB Nutclif Master, 10 11 LLC have entered into a settlement, which requires, among other things, the adoption of the Redevelopment 12 13 Area --We will, right? The settlement, right? 14 15 Whereas, FAR Planning has prepared for the Township a Redevelopment Plan, dated June 18th, 2025, 16 entitled "Roche Southside Kingsland Street 17 18 Redevelopment Plan", which provides development 19 standards and uses for the Redevelopment Area; Whereas, on July 1, 2025, the Board of 20 21 Commissioners held a public hearing and voted to adopt Ordinance 3589, accepting and approving the Roche 22 23 Southside Kingsland Street Redevelopment Plan; 24 Whereas, the Board of Commissioners has reviewed the submissions and qualifications of PB 25

Nutclif Master, LLC, and finds that PB Nutclif Master,

LLC possesses the necessary resources and experience to

redevelop the -- to -- to redevelop an area in

accordance with the Redevelopment Plan;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Nutley, County of Essex, New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals be and hereby are incorporated herein as if repeated at length; and
- 2. PB Nutclif Master be and hereby is designated the redeveloper of the redevelopment area covered by the Southside Kingsland Street Redevelopment Plan, subject to the subsequent approval and execution of the redevelopment agreement with the Township; and
- 3. The Township Administration and Township Attorney be and hereby are authorized to take any necessary and reasonable actions in furtherance of the same.
