WHEREAS, on May 21, 2025, the Redeveloper submitted an application to the Board for a waiver of residential development fees in connection with the redevelopment pursuant to Township Code Section 285-4(C)(3), which application lists various public benefits of the redevelopment project, including the construction of a total of 125 public parking spaces, the construction of a 5,000 square foot park, the investments in town property and utility infrastructure, and the commitment from the Redeveloper to pay costs to remediate existing environmental conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Township and its professionals have reviewed the Redeveloper's application and have recommended that the Board grant the application and waive residential development fees in connection with the Franklin Avenue redevelopment.
