Subject: Public Comment for April 6 Meeting: Public Nuisance and Fire Hazard at 774 6th Street

To the Crescent City Council and City Manager et al,

I am writing to formally report a persistent public nuisance and safety hazard located at **774 6th Street**.

As a neighbor, I am concerned about the continued neglect of this property. A **Correction Notice** (Job #24-RME) was issued by the Building Department on **February 11, 2024**, declaring this structure **"NOT FIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION"** due to infestation, structural failure, and lack of essential services.

It has now been over two years since that notice was posted, and the property remains a significant threat to our neighborhood:

- **Fire Hazard:** The grass is currently over two feet tall, creating a massive fuel load right next to occupied homes.
- **Public Health:** The "infestation" noted by the city inspector remains unaddressed, affecting surrounding properties.
- **Safety:** The structure is abandoned and deteriorating, attracting illegal activity and reducing local property values.

Since no corrective work has been performed since early 2024, I am requesting that the City move forward with **Administrative Abatement and Demolition**. Our neighborhood should not have to wait another year for a "dangerous building" to be cleared.

I have attached a photo of the city's own Correction Notice for your reference. I look forward to a response regarding the city's timeline for clearing this site.
